Thursday Feb 27

Some rain. we are lost under a dark storm. The
ship heading A/C. Looked for him fastened and
killed him not looking much was running he is
a small one got him along side took in sail standing
Boat crew Tackel up the A/C. Looked at day light
manned the wheel up and put him in not very
far ahead up deck spoke the Barque & Keelberg port
of Stonington 1800 was raising some see no Whales

Friday Feb 28

Spoke a man at the wheel. Left went aboard
took in sail standing Boat crew Tackel
at hand at day light make sail the
Barque in sight see Whales lowered for

them three they were Breaching top Tackling
held on with rope a no much of a sea on
two men in the Club Room butting horse
piece the Boat is going to let a day think
it will make more

Thursday March 1

Lowered again carried away Post Mast very
rough came on board scraped some Bone
cleared up decks washed of clutter reeled
top sail down jib and main sail. Heading
Boat crew Tackel some the wind incre-
ased on the most Boats crew furl'd Fore and
Main top sails not much rain but blowing
a Gale of Wind at times the Boat goes when
gives orders to call from if blow changes all
hands called to put things in readiness for trying
out started running and put the Boat
a Gale of Wind heading A/C the first of March

Friday March 3, 2nd Gale of Wind

Started the work furl'd the Fore sail. There
water some could down there is a bad sea on
there owing to the shallowness of the water.
Close up'd main top sail put the Boat
on the upper canvas standing Boat crew
colder than I have seen at any time
The ship lay well up there is but a few
