Thursday May 17th Lat 40.48

That ship a whaling 22 men whales on the beam pulled
after them but to no purpose took in ~~the~~ ^{and} hatching the
wheel this morning made sail at day light - foggy raised wheel
on the beam and off for them lower on then they set in and
we did not see the whales again visited the Boats men about but you
can see fether of deck than been shot in one left thick fog can not
see a ship with Boats around the ship

Friday May 18th

Thick fog nothing doing took in top Gall sails pulled their
sail braced up fore sail hauled down the fore square in the
yard Steer S & C the weather is rather thick called the Cook
called all hands made sail not much wind three ships in sight
there is a heavy bank off to the windward it looks some like land

Saturday May 19th Lat 41.00

Sea too right whales three they were going to the other
and Westward very fast lower for them but to no purpose
we had took in top Gall sails the sails and jibs not wind

All hands at day light made sail very little wind saw one Whales was a

Sunday May 20th

Thinking or saying to myself that at the first of the present

took in top Gall sails and jibs braced up the Cores laid the main
