Saturday June 9th

Bone Shrike and whales in sight. One
boat landed a shark dead when rather thick weather
a little breeze spring up. Boats morning to sail in sight one
of them is a large schooner of Warrington she landed her boats
fastened and killed him. We landed there for whales most of
the whales that are here are large ones and they all appear
to be sleeping good and.

Sunday June 10th

Our Boats are taken plenty of whales in sight can
get away enough to catch the Boats. Steered up and then they are
gone. Went to the ship. Strong breeze steering at 100°
fine morning. Light night. Think it good. Coler as to get off.
North can hear whales moan. Spouting. Hauled. Boats did not
land for whales did not get any. One ship in sight. Plus
or whales but did not. Over. Mending Boat. Sail firing
settling on the rigging.

Monday June 11th

Land in sight. Steering fine on the quarter set
sail. Steering at 100° plenty of whales on ship in sight.

one of the men is sick with the Rheumatism or a cold
which has settled in his limbs. Fine weather. Hauled down
the hind having hauled up the weather
side of the main sail. One saw some small boats. Looked at in
sight but did not over for them nothing doing.

Tuesday June 12th Lat 45.30 N

Went in to get to repair plenty of whales in
sight. Steering at 100° for the night. The wind took us
hard back. Hauled down. Set sail. Braced up. Strong. Fished. Top. Gall
sails and main sail. Hauled up. Fine sail up. Cable and sent it
not knowing but it might have some use for it. Below. Long
saw. Ship for him. Did away a little. Find there is a peak of
the Island very high. Can see the sun on it very plain
a new kind. It has died away. Little got the ship. Put out to look
on it. Two ships in sight. The wind hauled a little so that
we steered our course bent. The ship hauled ahead again.

Wednesday June 13th Lat 45.34

Steered down. Hauled. Little did there was on deck. The
wind increases. Took in top Gall sails. The ship hauled. Main sail
hauled up. Top sail. Hauled. Steered. Hauled. Top. Sails. Fished.
The ship put the Boats on the upper. Came. But the wind is right
of shore can see some quite plain. Think it is 10 or 20 miles distant.
Saw a rather large standing quater. Hauled. Fine. Increased. Fished. Boats
Went to sail. The wind does not blow but a short time from
the same direction. Haul. Ship close reefed. Main. Hauled.
Hauled. Main sail. Set again. Spencer. Find the legs better.

Thursday June 14th

Went up. Steered. Boat. Hauled. The so did some ship.
