wind increases took in Fore & Main top of F.M. Sail. By 10th
head of B.C. the wind still increases think we are going to have
rough weather the wind being out to the clothing makes it quite
unpleasant here closed up Main top F.M. Sail and furl'd it the wind did not
increase any more head of B.C.

Monday June 18th Lat 46.25
One man slipped it makes a man ship his hands that is aloft
or at the wheel. Mr. J. B. Schmitt & J. B. Schmitt were agreed to her on one or two
spots that they all rather were heading N. B. B. On the last board took
some beer but cold broke out for later broke later broke out
and heads in broke out a cash of sand not much laid out quite
to end B

Friday June 19th
Filled two Barks with salt water one ship in sight
we fired 3 barrels of powder and chained the ship
heads & 100 ft cord N on Pump Boat or something else could
not tell for certain & good distance & it began to rain
