Remarks Tuesday July 19th
 this 24 hours begins with light wind heding
 to the Eastward one sail in sight at sundown
 took in sail latter part fine weather
 spoke brig Iron Bristol left Grinnell
 around this day lat 35°44' N Long 40°06' W

Remarks Thursday July 20th
 this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze
 from N.E. clearing Eastward at sundown
 took in sail for the night latter part
 fine weather steaming to the Eastward
 1 sail in sight saw sperm whale
 around this day lat 35°00' N Long 38°00' W

Remarks Friday July 21st
 this 24 hours begins with fine weather
 saw sperm whale board 3 boats in
 company with the brig caught none
 at sundown took in sail for the night
 latter part calm weather around this day
 lat 36°10' N Long 39°21' W

Remarks Saturday July 22nd
 this 24 hours begins with calm weather
 nothing in sight at sundown shortened
 sail for the night latter part calm
 nothing in sight around this day
 lat 36°36' N Long 39°10' W

Remarks Sunday July 23rd
 this 24 hours begins with light breeze
 from the westward heding Eastward
 at 3 P.M. saw sperm whale going
 quick did not rear at sundown shortened
 sail for the night latter part squally
 around this day lat 36°36' N Long 39°10' W

Remarks Monday July 24th
 this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze and
 heavy steaming E at sundown shortened
 sail for the night latter part fine
 weather steaming Eastward imflow
 in ship duty lat 36°46' Long 36°12'

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Remarks Tuesday July 25th 1843
 this 24 hours begins with fine weather steaming
 E by S nothing in sight at sundown took in
 top gallant sails and fly sail latter part
 light breeze imflow in ship duty around
 lat 36°43' N Long 35°46'

Remarks Wednesday July 26th
 this 24 hours begins with light wind and
 calm imflow in ship duty at sundown
 took in fly sail clearing Eastward latter
 part the same imflow in ship duty
 duty around this day lat 37°34' North
 Long 35°00' West

Remarks Thursday July 27th
 this 24 hours begins with fine weather
 steaming Eastward all sail set imflow
 in ship duty one sail in sight Mid
 latter calm weather imflow in fitting
 rigging around this day lat 38°20' N
 Long 34°35' W

Remarks Friday July 28th
 this 24 hours begins with light breeze heding
 to the Eastward 2 sail in sight Mid part
 light breeze steaming East all drawing
 sail set latter part fine weather
 imflow in ship duty around this day
 lat 38°55' N Long 33°48' West

Remarks Saturday July 29th
 this day begins with fine weather steaming
 East all drawing sail set 2 sail in sight
 Mid part the same latter part light
 wind from the West steaming East around
 this day lat 38°59' N Long 32°48' West

Remarks Sunday July 30th
 this day begins with light winds from Westward
 steaming East all drawing sail set Mid part
 fine weather at 6 P.M. saw the ahead of
 Howe sailing East Dist. 55 Miles latter
 part steaming E by S around this day
 lat 38°52' Long 31°11'
