Remarks Friday August 10th 1843
 then 24 hours begins with light wind from
 S.E. bearing of Trussarah at sundown shortened
 sail for the night saw grampuses latter
 part fine with sound this day

Remarks Saturday August 11th
 then 24 hours begins with fine with bearing
 of Trussarah spoke large Emergence later
 Capt Russell spoke brig Iron Capt Grinnell
 Mid part steering S.E. latter part light
 wind from N. steering S.E. of G
 saw grampuses sound then 24 hours

Remarks Sunday August 12th
 then 24 hours begins with light
 breeze from N.W. steering S.E. of G
 all drawing sail set Trussarah in
 sight Mid part Rainy latter part
 light breeze and calm sound this day
 Lat 58° 48' N Long 16° 12' W

Remarks Monday August 13th
 this day begins with light breeze and calm
 bearing S.E. of Trussarah in sight Lat 59° 10' N
 W. N.W. Mid part light breeze from E. S. E.
 bearing to the southward latter part
 fine breeze steering S. all drawing sail set
 sound this day Lat 59° 11' N

Remarks Tuesday August 14th
 then 24 hours begins with fine with
 at 1 P.M. saw the island of St. Michel
 bearing S.E. dist 30 miles Mid part fine
 breeze from Eastward steering S. latter part
 the same saw St. Marys bearing E. S. E.
 dist 58 miles sound this day Lat 59° 58' N
 Long 16° 50' W

Remarks Wednesday August 15th
 first part of this 24 hours begins with fine
 breeze from Eastward steering S. all drawing
 sail set Mid part steering S.E. all
 drawing sail set latter part
 the same sound this day Lat 60° 32' N
 Long 17° 56' W

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Remarks Thursday August 16th
 first part of this 24 hours begins with fresh
 breeze from N.E. steering S.E. all drawing
 sail set at 5 P.M. took in port of gaffail
 Mid part strong breeze from N.E. steering
 S.E. sound then 24 hours Lat 61° 05' N
 Long 18° 58' W

Remarks Friday August 17th
 first part of this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze
 from N.E. steering S.E. at 4 P.M. left of G
 Mid part strong breeze from N.E. steering
 S.E. sound then 24 hours Lat 61° 43' N Long 19° 55' W

Remarks Saturday August 18th
 first part of this 24 hours begins with fresh
 breeze at N.E. steering S.E. all drawing sail
 set at 1 P.M. took in fly jib steering South
 Mid part fresh breeze at N.E. steering S.E.
 sound then 24 hours Lat 62° 48' N Long 19° 14' W

Remarks Sunday August 19th
 first part of this 24 hours begins with strong
 breeze from N.E. steering S.E. all drawing
 sail set Mid part fresh breeze took in
 fore topgallant hane and fly jib latter part more
 moderate set them again steering S.E. of G
 sound then 24 hours Lat 63° 16' N Long 19° 22' W

Remarks Monday August 20th
 first part of this 24 hours begins with fresh
 breeze and flying clouds wind from N. and East
 steering S.E. of G and drawing sail set Mid
 part the same latter part fresh breeze
 sound then 24 hours Lat 63° 46' N Long 19° 18' W

Remarks Tuesday August 21st
 first part of this 24 hours begins with fresh
 breeze at 4 P.M. left of G
 all drawing sail set Mid part the same
 latter part fresh gales from N.E. singly
 mast port of trail steering S.W. of G
 sound then 24 hours Lat 64° 13' N Long 19° 02' W
