first part of the 24 hours begins with light
wind from N and Eastward steering S S E all
drawing sail set mid part light wind and
rany latter part calm impleid in making
spongyame drend this day lat 11° 51' N long 144° 39'

saw blackfish

Remarks Tuesday Sept 5th
first part of the 24 hours begins light wind
and calm impleid in making spongyame mid
part light wind and rany steering S S E latter
part fine was from W S W and cloudy
steering S S E all sail set drend
the 24 hours lat 11° 54' N long 144° 04' West

4 sail in sight

Remarks Wednesday Sept 6th
first part of the 24 hours begins with
fresh breeze from S W steering on the
wind to the south Eastward at 1/2 4 P.M. took
in fore top gallant sails and fly like mid part
fine breeze from S W latter part rany drend
the 24 hours lat 12° 10' N long 144° 19' N

from S W hiding S S E at 1/2 past 3 P.M. took

took ship to S S E drend the 24 hours
lat 13° 15' N long 140° 04' W

saw one sail steering
S S E

Remarks Monday Sept 11th
first part of the 24 hours begins with fresh
breeze from S W steering S S E mid part
the same at 4 P.M. took ship to the S S W
at 4 P.M. took to the S S E fine breeze and
good weather drend this day lat 13° 47' N long 139° 50' W

Remarks Tuesday Sept 12th
first part of the 24 hours begins with
fine rather steering S S E all sail set
at 1/2 past 5 P.M. took to the W S W
mid part fine breeze latter part took to S S E
at 4 P.M. saw 8 blackfish and caught none
drend the 24 hours lat 14° 12' N long 139° 11' N

Remarks Wednesday Sept 13th
first part of the 24 hours begins with fresh
breeze from S W and cloudy steering S Eastward
mid part the same latter part took
to the Westward light breeze and cloudy
impleid in ship's duty drend the 24 hours
lat 14° 51' N long 138° 30' N

Remarks Thursday Sept 14th
first part of the twenty four hours begins
with light wind all around compass and
rany mid part steering S W wind
at S S W latter part the same light
wind and rany drend lat 15° 01' N long 138° 51' W

one sail in sight

Remarks Friday Sept 15th
first part of the twenty four hours begins
with light wind from S S W at 1 P.M. took
to the S Eastward at 4 P.M. saw blackfish
board 3 boats caught none mid part breeze
and squally wind at S S W latter the same
hiding to the westward drend lat 15° 50' N long 138° 10' W
