Remarks Monday Nov 27<sup>th</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fine weather fresh strong down at sundown took in sail for the night latter part breeze and range at 4 P.M. saw right whale got about down from over head and put her on the beam at 1 P.M. I'll have 3 boats but caught none come on board during this day lat 36° 11' N

Remarks Tuesday Nov 28<sup>th</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fresh breeze and range at 4 P.M. about noon main topsail and jibed fore sail. Mid part the same latter part fresh breeze and range wind at N E down there 24 hours lat 36° 06' N

Remarks Wednesday Nov 29<sup>th</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fresh breeze and range going to under short sail. Mid part the same latter part fine weather down there 24 hours lat 36° 13' South

Remarks Thursday Nov 30<sup>th</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fine weather at 4 P.M. saw right whales board 3 boats did not get past come on board and took in sail. Mid latter fine weather saw right whales going to windward board 2 boats did not get past come on board down there 24 hours lat 36° 43' S long 9° 56' W

Remarks Friday December 1<sup>st</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fine weather saw plenty right whales board but got none at sundown took in sail for the night latter part fresh breeze spoke barque Delta of Bondport left Smith 5 months out down there 24 hours lat 36° 42' S long 9° 48' W

Remarks Saturday December 2<sup>nd</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fresh breeze and clear weather at sundown took in sail for the night latter part fresh breeze saw right whales board but did not get past down there 24 hours lat 36° 55' South

first part of their 24 hours begins with light breeze set fore topsail ab and foresail wind from W and foggy at sundown took in sail for the night latter part foggy at 2 P.M. saw right whales board one boat did not get my them come on board down there 24 hours lat 36° 59' S

Remarks Wednesday December 6<sup>th</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with fine weather saw right whales board 3 boats could not get on come on board took in sail for the night latter part light wind and foggy down there 24 hours lat 36° 41' S long 9° 55' W

Remarks Thursday December 7<sup>th</sup>  
first part of their 24 hours begins with light wind from the N and foggy clearing S of W at sundown took in sail for the night latter part light wind and foggy down there 24 hours lat 36° 50' S

first part of their 24 hours begins with light wind and foggy. Mid part 4 P.M. saw right whales going quick to windward board 3 boats did not get my them at sundown took in sail for the night latter part fine weather down there 24 hours lat 36° 44' S long 9° 35' W
