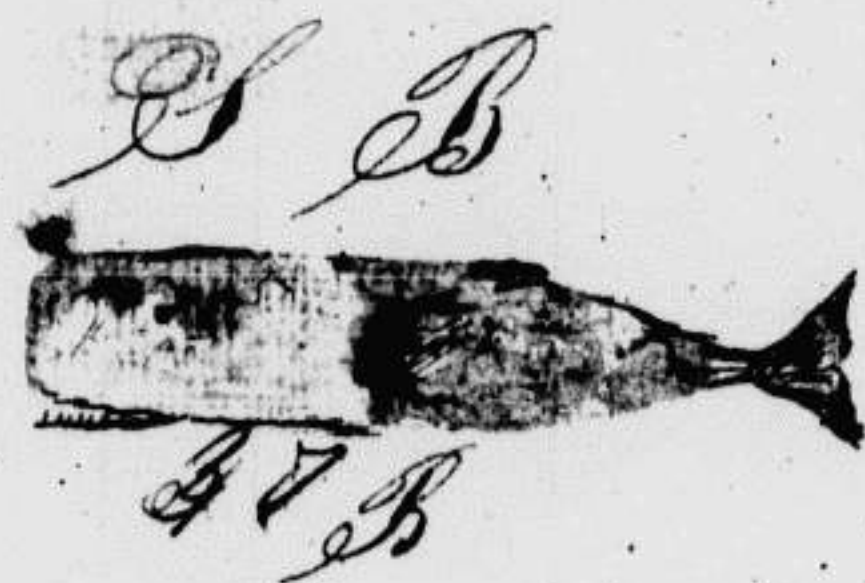


Remarks on Board Brig Juno West of Block M

 first part of these 24 hours begins with  
 light winds from the N hailing N.W.  
 at sundown took in sail for the night  
 latter part light winds from the N hailing  
 E by S down lat 31° 53' S long 111° 11' W

Remarks Friday Decem 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 first part of these 24 hours begins with  
 light breeze hailing the Eastward at  
 sundown took in sail latter part light  
 wind from S and cloudy steering N by E  
 down this day lat 31° 58' S long 110° 11' W

Remarks Saturday Decem 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 first part of these 24 hours begins with fresh  
 breeze and cloudy steering N by E at 2 P.M.  
 saw Spum Whales four boats got one to the  
 S Boat got him along side and commenced  
 cutting the part fresh breeze and cloudy latter  
 fine rather fresh buting and commenced boiling  
 down this day lat 31° 34' S long 111° 11' W

Remarks Sunday Decem 24<sup>th</sup>  
 first part of these 24 hours fine rather all hands  
 employed in boiling hailing S by W latter part  
 cloudy latter part fine rather boiling  
 down this day lat 31° 45' S long 110° 40' W

Remarks Monday Decem 25<sup>th</sup>  
 first part of these 24 hours begins with  
 fine rather at 2 P.M. finish boiling  
 and cleared up decks at sundown took  
 in sail latter part fine rather commenced  
 steering down down this day lat 31° 52' S

 first part of these 24 hours begins with  
 fine rather finish storing down and  
 cleared up decks at sundown took in sail  
 latter part fine rather brushing for  
 spum Whales down lat 31° 26' S long 111° 55' W

 Remarks Wednesday Decem 27<sup>th</sup>  
 first part of these 24 hours begins with fine  
 rather winds from S E steering E by N  
 at sundown took in sail for the night  
 latter part fine breeze from S E steering  
 N by E all drawing sail set in flood in  
 fitting butting strapps down this day  
 lat 30° 10' S long 114° 14' W

Nothing in sight

Remarks Thursday Decem 28<sup>th</sup>  
 first part of these 24 hours begins  
 with fresh breeze from S E steering  
 N by E finish the strapps at sundown  
 took in sail steering N by E fresh breeze  
 from S E and cloudy latter part the same lat 29° 36' S

Remarks Friday Decem 29<sup>th</sup>  
 this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from  
 S E and rugged steering N by E at sundown  
 took in sail latter part fresh breeze and  
 rainy steering N by E down this day  
 lat 29° 55' S long 118° 18' W

Nothing in sight

Remarks Saturday Decem 30<sup>th</sup>  
 this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from  
 S E and flying clouds steering N by E at  
 sundown shortened sail for the night  
 latter part fresh breeze from S E steering  
 N N E some rain squalls down this day  
 lat 29° 26' S long 120° 33' W

Nothing in sight

Remarks Sunday Decem 31<sup>st</sup>  
 this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from  
 S E and squally steering N N E  
 at sundown shortened sail for the night  
 steering N N E latter part fine rather  
 steering the same down this day

Saw 2 sail

Remarks January 1<sup>st</sup> 1844 the Monday  
 first part of these 24 hours begins with  
 fine rather winds from S E steering  
 N N E all drawing sail set at sundown  
 shortened sail latter part fine rather  
 down this day employed in making rig  
 rigging lat 29° 5' S long 124° 8' W
