Mid part the same latter part fine
weather steering W S W ends this day
Lat 14° 48' S Long 141° 41' W

Remarks Monday Jan 15th 1844
first part of this 24 hours begins with fine
weather wind from E & steering W S W
Mid part the same latter part steering
W by S all drawing sail set ends
Lat 17° 46' S Long 144° 28' W

Remarks Tuesday January 16th
first part of this 24 hours begins with
fine weather steering W by S all
drawing sail set Mid latter fine weather
steering W S W ends this day
Lat 18° 25' S Long 146° 05' W

Remarks Wednesday January 17th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
wind from S & steering W S W
all drawing sail set Mid latter fine
weather ends Lat 19° 37' S Long 148° 25' W

Remarks Thursday Jan 18th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
wind from S & steering W S W all drawing
sail set at 4th part 5 P M Made the
island of Trinidad bearing W S W
Dist 85 miles steering W S W Mid part
begin two under short sail latter part
going off Trinidad one boat crew
in board fishing ends this
day fresh breeze and rugged could
not land Long 149° 10' W

1 sail in sight

clear weather at 4 P M made sail
steering W S W all drawing sail set
Mid latter the same one sail in sight
ends this day Lat 20° 04' S

this 24 hours begins with fine weather
wind from S & steering W S W all
drawing sail set Mid latter the same
steering W S W ends this
day Lat 19° 31' S Long 154° 03' W

Remarks Sunday January 21th
this day begins with fine weather steering
W S W all drawing sail set on boat
main signal Mid latter fine weather steering
latter part the same steering W S W
ends this day Lat 19° 03' S Long 155° 53' W

Brook out one

first part of this 24 hours begins with fine
weather steering S W took in foremast
studding sail at sundown took in sail
for the night latter part fine weather
ends this day Lat 18° 05' S Long 157° 00' W

one sail in sight

this 24 hours begins with fine weather
steering on the wind S S W cruising
for sperm whales at sundown took in sail
latter part fine weather cruising for
sperm whales ends Lat 17° 44' S Long 158° 36' W

Remarks Wednesday January 24th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
wind from S & at sundown took in sail for
the night Mid latter fine weather ends
this day Lat 17° 58' S Long 159° 46' W
