this day got fine weather lying at anchor

down one watch on shore sends this day
lying at anchor fresh breeze from N.E.

Remarks Monday March 25th
this day fresh breeze from Eastward lying
at anchor at 9 A.M. took our anchor
and went to sea fresh breeze from E.N.E.
steering N.W. bound to St. Eustacia
sends this day

Remarks Tuesday March 26th
this 24 hours lying with fresh breeze
from N.E. steering N.W. at 3 P.M.
about 9 gale loop mid part light
wind and sun rain latter part fresh breeze
at 10 P.M. made St. Eustacia bearing N.E. 20
miles sends this day

Remarks Wednesday March 27th
this 24 hours begin with fresh breeze from N.E.
at 11 P.M. St. Eustacia bear E.N.E. 20
miles left off N.W. for St. Thomas
mid part lying aback latter hauld up
for St. Thomas sends this day to Thomas in sight

Remarks Thursday March 28th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather beating
in to St. Thomas at 1 P.M. came to anchor
mid part fine weather latter part the same
sends one watch on shore

Remarks Friday March 29th
this day fine weather lying at anchor
one watch one shoar mid latter
fresh breeze from N.E. lying at
anchor at St. Thomas sends this day

this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from N.E.
steering to the westward at 11 P.M. 4 P.M.
came to anchor to the W. end of Crab Island
mid latter fresh breeze lying at anchor
at Crab Island sends this day

Remarks Monday April 1st
this day begins with fresh breeze from
N.E. lying at anchor at Crab Island
all hands implied in cutting wood
and getting it off sends this day
fresh breeze from the N.E.

Remarks Tuesday April 2nd
this day begins with fresh breeze lying
at anchor cutting wood and getting off mid
latter the same lying at anchor sends
this day fresh gale from N.E.

Remarks Wednesday April 3rd
this day begins with fresh breeze from
N. Eastward lying at anchor at Crab Island
getting wood mid latter the same so
sends this day fine weather

Remarks Thursday April 4th
this day begins with fine weather lying at
anchor fresh getting wood mid part at anchor
at 8 P.M. took the anchor and
went to sea bound to Polovina sends
this day light wind from N.E.
