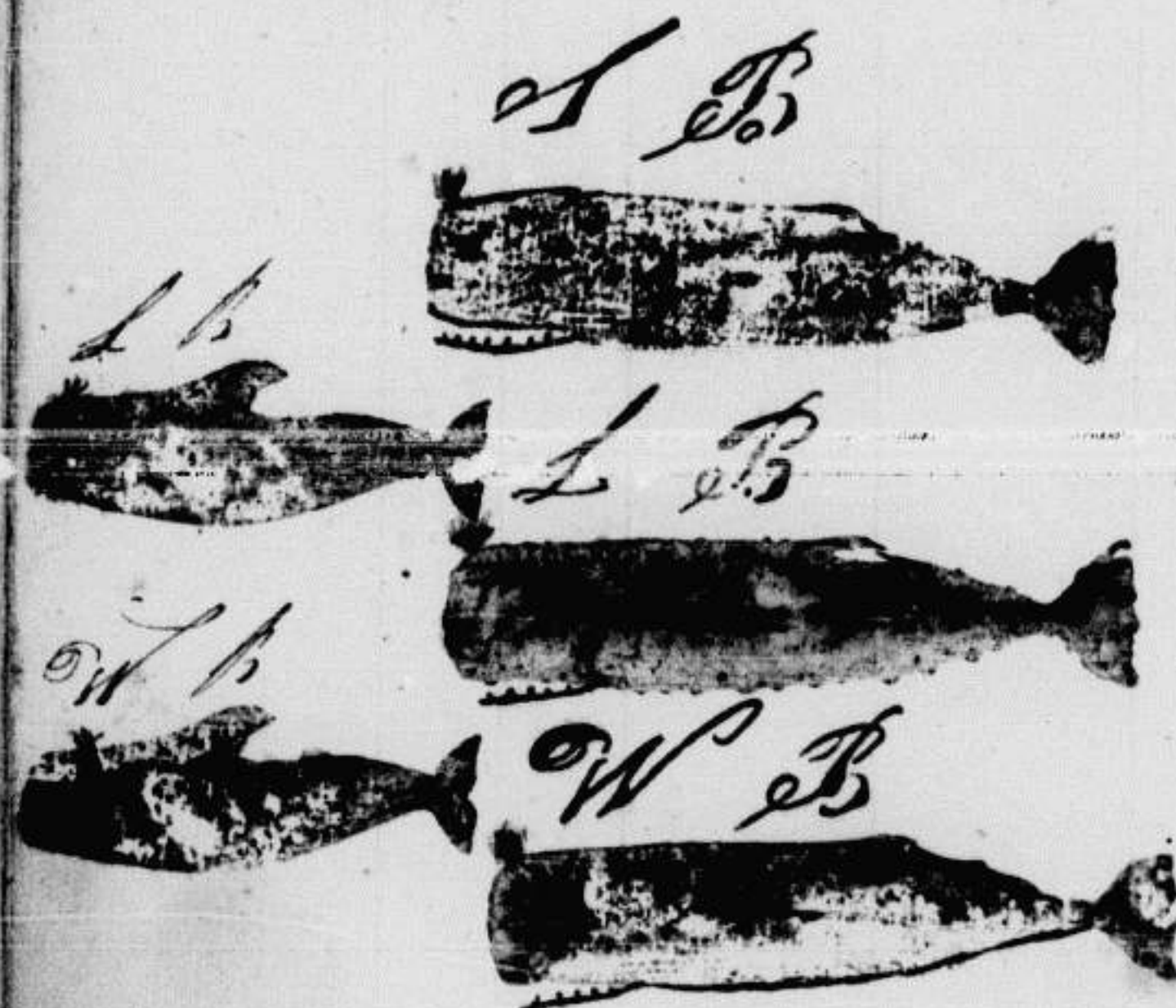


Remarks on Board Brig Juno Westport & Cook's bay

Remarks Friday April 5th
this 24 hours begins with light wind from
N E bringing of potatoes for spurs
whales at sundown took in sail for the
night latter part fine weather bringing of
potatoes aboard this day

Remarks Saturday April 6th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
at 4 P.M. saw blackfish board 3 boats
laught 1 one to L B one to W B took in
sail for the night at 9 P.M. saw spurs
whale board 3 boats brought 3 and took them
along side aboard this day

Remarks Sunday April 7th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
commonest butting at sundown fish
butting in two of them took in sail
hiding to E S E at daylight commonest
butting the other fish butting and heard
up decks aboard this day

Remarks Monday April 8th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
commonest butting mid part the same
latter part fresh breeze and rugg
all hands employed in boiling aboard this day

Remarks Tuesday April 9th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze
from E S E and rarer mid part the
same boiling latter part fresh gale
at 1/2 past 11 P.M. fresh boiling aboard this day

Remarks Wednesday April 10th
this 24 hours begins with fresh gale from
eastward heard up decks and warth off
mid part fresh breeze latter part commonest
stowing down aboard this day fresh
breeze and rugg

Remarks Thursday April 11th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from
eastward fresh stowing down the oil mid
part the same latter part heard up decks
and warth off aboard this day fresh gale and squally

Remarks Friday April 12th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from
eastward and sun rain under short sail
mid part the same of potatoes latter
part more moderate saw nothing
aboard this 24 hours

Remarks Saturday April 13th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
bringing of potatoes at 4 P.M. squally
and plenty of rain wind from the N E took
in sail mid part light wind latter part
below aboard this day

Remarks Sunday April 14th
this 24 hours begins with light wind
and variable at sundown took in sail
for the night latter part light wind
from N E aboard this day

Remarks Monday April 15th
this 24 hours begins with calm weather
bringing of potatoes one sail in sight
at sundown took in sail for the night
latter part light wind aboard this day

Remarks Tuesday April 16th
this 24 hours begins with light wind
and variable at sundown took in sail
latter part light wind from N E
aboard this day but 10.10 N by 16.51 off

one sail in sight
