N.E. bearing four sperm whales of various

standing head watches latter part calm

this 24 hours begins with light winds and
variable sent down mantopgallantails
and bent another one Mid part fresh breeze from
E.S.E. heading N.N.W. latter part calm off the
W end of potatoes sounds this day

2 sail in sight

Remarks Friday April 15th
this 24 hours begins with light winds and
variable heading to the N.W. Mid part
fresh breeze from N.E. steering on the wind
to the N.W. at daylight Mona island bears
W by N dist 15 miles steering N.W. on
the wind closes this day

Remarks Saturday April 16th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from
N.E. steering on the wind to N.W. at 4 P.M.
bore Engano N.E. end of Sandemingo
bore W by N dist 15 miles Mid latter fine
sends this day lat 19° 10' N long 168° 45' W

Remarks Sunday April 17th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
winds from N.E. steering on the wind to the
N.W. Mid part tack to the S.E. latter part
heading N.N.W. at 8 P.M. saw blackfish
bore caught 6 and took them along side
sends this day 19° 16' N long 169° 06' W

Remarks Monday April 18th
this day begins with fine weather all hands
implied in sealing blackfish heading to the S.E. Mid latter heading N.N.W.
implied in sealing blackfish closes lat 19° 53' N long 169° 04' W

Remarks Tuesday April 18th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather heading
on the wind to the N. heading at 2 P.M.
fresh boiling blackfish and light of W by N
at 4 P.M. all sail set on the wind to S.E. and
took in sail latter part heading to the N.W.
at 10 P.M. made seven beak and sends this
day lat 20° 35' N long 170° 11' W

Remarks Wednesday April 19th
this day begins with light winds and varying
steering N.W. bore three silver line
passage Mid part steering N by W latter
part steering N.N.W. fresh breeze from
N.E. sends this day lat 21° 53' N long 170° 51' W

Remarks Thursday April 20th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from
N.E. steering N.N.W. Mid part the same
latter part steering N.W. at 10 P.M.
tack to the S.E. sends this
day lat 23° 14' N long 171° 59' W

Remarks Friday April 21st
this 24 hours begins with fine weather heading
to the Eastward winds from N.N.E. at 2 P.M.
tack to the N.W. Mid part steering S.E.
at 12 M tack to the N by W latter
part fine weather sends lat 24° 8' N long 176° 16' W
