from W Stearing E by N at sundown
shortened sail for the night Mid part rainy
winds from N E latter part fine weather
hiding E winds this day lat 55° 12' N Long 60° 57' W

Remarks Saturday May 15th

Brook out one
sixty Molasses

saw large Stearing
S E

from the North hiding E by N at sundown
shortened sail for the night latter part
fine weather Stearing on the wind to the E
winds from the N lat 55° 08' N

saw brig Stearing
N E W

this 24 hours begins with fine weather
winds from the S hiding to the Eastward
at sundown shortened sail for the night
latter part Stearing E N E winds from
W by W winds this day lat 55° 33' N Long 57° 57' W

Remarks Monday 17th

this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from
W by W Stearing E N E at sundown
shortened sail for the night latter
part the same winds this day
lat 56° 35' N Long 58° 05' W

this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from
W by W and Rugged Stearing E N E under
short sail latter part the same
winds this day lat 57° 12' N Long 58° 30' W

in sail and was to hiding S fresh breeze
and Rugged Mid part the same latter

Remarks Thursday May 20th

this 24 hours begins with fresh gales from
W by W lying to under short sail Mid part
the same latter part fresh breeze and
Rugged lying to hiding to the South winds
lat by 58° 33' N Long None

this 24 hours begins with fresh gales and
Rugged lying to Mid part more moderate
latter part fine weather winds from the N
Stearing E by N winds lat 57° 25' N Long 58° 28'

winds from N N E Stearing E by N at
sundown shortened sail for the night latter
part fine weather Stearing to the Eastward
winds this day lat 57° 3' N Long 50° 33' W
