Remarks Tuesday June 4<sup>th</sup> 1844

this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
winds from Eastward heding to the S  
at sundown took in sail for the night  
mid part the same latter part calm  
saw this day lat 37° 11' N

Remarks Wednesday June 5<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
winds from N W steering E by S at  
sundown took in sail for the night  
latter part fine weather steering  
E by S saw this day lat 36° 52' N long 45° 52' W

Remarks Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
winds from S E steering S E at  
sundown took in sail for the night  
latter part light winds and variable  
and heavy snow this day lat 34° 14' N

Remarks Friday June 7<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with light winds  
and clear weather at sundown took in  
sail for the night latter part fine  
weather saw this day lat 35° 44' N long 45° 50' W

Remarks Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
bussing for S whales at sundown  
took in sail for the night latter  
part fine weather saw this day  
lat 36° 33' N long 44° 51' W

Remarks Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
heding to the S winds from N W  
at sundown shortened sail for the night  
latter part fine weather saw this day  
lat 35° 28' N long 45° 49' W

weather saw this day lat 35° 56' N long 46° 48' W

Remarks Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
light winds and variable heding S E  
at sundown took in sail for the night  
latter part light winds from N W  
steering to the Eastward impleid in  
Mending parails saw this day  
lat 36° 15' N long 41° 58' W

Remarks Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
heding to the Eastward finish the parails  
and hunt it at sundown took in sail  
for the night steering E by N latter  
part the same saw this day lat 36° 36' N long 40° 25' W

Remarks Thursday June 13<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
bussing for whales at sundown took  
in sail for the night latter part  
fine weather saw this day steering  
Eastward lat 36° 44' N long 39° 44' W

Remarks Friday June 14<sup>th</sup>  
this 24 hours begins with fine weather  
winds from the South heding to the  
westward at sundown took in sail for  
the night latter part fine weather  
saw this day lat 36° 15' N long 39° 46' W

this 24 hours begins with fine weather winds  
from the S heding to the Eastward at  
sundown took in sail for the night  
latter part fine weather saw this day  
lat 36° 10' N long 39° 16' W
