Remarks Sunday June 16th 1844
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
winds from the S blowing to the westward
at sundown took in sail for the night
latter part fine weather & good this day
Lat. 48° 55' N Long. 124° 45' W

Remarks Monday June 17th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze
from the S blowing Eastward at sundown
took in sail for the night latter
part fresh breeze from the S blowing
Returned on this day Lat 48° 44' N Long 124° 41' W

Remarks Tuesday June 18th
this 24 hours begins with fresh breeze
and hazy day W by S at sundown
took in sail for the night latter
part light wind from N W and
foggy do not see Lat 48° 54' N Long 124° 43' W

Remarks Wednesday June 19th
this 24 hours begins with light wind and
vague hazy to the Westward at sundown
took in sail for the night latter
part fine weather saw Blackfish board
caught none do not see this day Lat 48° 49' N

Remarks Thursday June 20th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
steering S W by S winds from S E at
sundown took in sail for the night
latter part fine weather & good this day
Lat 48° 40' N Long 124° 53' W

Remarks Friday June 21st
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
blowing for whales at sundown took in
sail for the night latter part fine
weather steering W S W do not see
Lat 48° 56' N Long 124° 44' W

Remarks Saturday June 22nd
this 24 hours begins with fine weather winds
from E N E steering W S W at S P M
saw Blackfish board caught none at sundown
took in sail for the night at S P M
saw sperm whale board caught one to S B
took him alongside and commenced butting in
do not see this day Lat 48° 39' N Long 124° 53' W

Remarks Sunday June 23rd
this day fine weather fresh butting and blowing
latter part fine weather in boiling do not see this day
Lat 48° 52' N

Remarks Monday June 24th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather
winds from S N E in flood in boiling
at S P M fresh blowing latter part commenced
steering down do not see this day 4 sail in
sight Lat 48° 44' N Long 124° 45' W

Remarks Tuesday June 25th
this 24 hours begins with fine weather fresh
steering down and warbled off at sundown
took in sail for the night latter part
fine weather do not see this day Lat 48° 40' N

Remarks Wednesday June 26th
this 24 hours begins with light wind from
the Eastward blowing for whales at
sundown took in sail for the night
latter part light wind from the Eastward
do not see this day Lat 48° 50' N Long 124° 05' W

Remarks Thursday June 27th
this 24 hours begins with calm weather
at sundown took in sail for the night
latter part wind from the Westward
latter part the same steering E N E
do not see this day Lat 49° 54' N
