Day open foggy. at 8:30 am. Steam up to the ice. we are made fast to it in 37 fathoms. Water. Ship drifting South with current on ice. Steamed for 2 hrs. Weather cleared up. Breeze bent. Breeze 3 pm. Tack ice about 5 miles off shore. Hove ship to at 9 pm.
