Remarks on board Wednesday December the 22<sup>nd</sup>

This day commenced with a fine breeze and good weather saw a number of fin backs saw one sail broke out for water and got three potatoes and urins on deck latitude 27.12 long 43.38 ship headed south east by south half south threw the day at one o'clock hauled ship headed north east by east threw the night so ends

Remarks on board Thursday December the 23<sup>rd</sup>

This day commenced with a fine breeze from east south east and good weather saw fin backs and one sail headed north east by east threw the day had a good breeze and fine weather threw the night latitude 27.12 long 42.50 so ends

Remarks on board Friday December the 24<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with a strong breeze and pleasant weather saw fin backs nothing going on worth remark latitude 27.12 longitude 41.54 stood to the southward the fore part of the night letter part to the northward and eastward so ends this day

Remarks on board Saturday December the 25<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with a strong breeze and ragged weather at seven o'clock hauled ship to the southward latitude 27.12 no log had nothing going on worth remark at three o'clock hauled ship again headed east by north had a strong breeze threw the night at two o'clock reefed the foretop sail and took in the middle top sail ship headed east threw the night so ends this day

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Remarks on board Sunday December the 26<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with a strong breeze from south south east and ragged weather at ten o'clock took in the mainsail and jib and set the top sail latitude 30.03 longitude 39.06 ship headed east by south by the wind steeled no mast heads this day had a strong breeze threw the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Monday December the 27<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with a moderate sail from north south east and a heavy sea running at seven o'clock furled the foretop sail continued to blow threw the day latitude 30.12 no log had at eleven o'clock began to moderate a little but still on blowing strong and thick and rainy weather threw the night so

Remarks on board Tuesday December the 28<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with a strong breeze and thick and rainy weather at ten o'clock set the foresail and hauled round a little to the westward stand south east by south continued to rain threw the day and night with light air and sun so ends this day

Remarks on board Wednesday December the 29<sup>th</sup>

This day commenced with a light breeze and thick and rainy weather at the foretop sail and middle top sail at one o'clock began to clear up a little and died away again nothing going on worth remark had a light breeze threw the night a large rainy weather stood south east by south at this day so ends this day
