Remarks on board Friday January the 14th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from the eastward and much smoke with men employed setting up rigging all this day latitude 25.59 longitude 19.40 steamed with the day at sundown took in the light sails steamed south through the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Saturday January the 15th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and pleasant weather men employed making out water and bread and other things steamed latitude 7.21 longitude 18.35 saw porpoises steamed south all this day at sundown took in sail and kept to the wind to the eastward had fine weather through the night so ends

Remarks on board Sunday January the 16th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north east and pleasant weather made sail and port round and steamed west south west latitude 6.16 longitude 18.40 at two o'clock raised blackfish and hord and got one look him along side and cut him in got three at four o'clock and washed off decks saw sun down took in sail and kept to the wind to the westward had thunder showers through the night with wind from all points of the compass so ends this day

Remarks on board Monday January the 17th 1859

This day commenced with fine weather but warm men employed working on the rigging latitude 6.11 longitude 18.05 this afternoon got a light breeze from the northward

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Made sail and steamed west north west men employed mending of the blackfish blades at sundown took in sail had several thunder squalls during the night but remainder calm so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday January the 18th 1859

This day commenced with sunny weather but warm at eight o'clock cleared up at eleven o'clock started the works and commenced hoisting at two o'clock got three pulleys down sent down warm through the day ship headed all points of the compass at eleven o'clock got a breeze from the north east headed to the northward and westward through the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Wednesday January the 19th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from north east and pleasant weather made sail headed north north west until ten o'clock then kept off before the wind steamed west latitude 6.54 longitude 20.49 at sundown took in sail and kept to the wind to the northward headed to the northward through the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Thursday January the 20th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from north east and off south south east saw a big clearing to the southward saw blackfish but did not hear this afternoon took out for water at sundown reefed the foretop sail and kept to the wind to the eastward latitude 6.16 longitude 21.26 headed to the eastward the fore part of the night later part to the westward light breeze and fine weather so ends this day
