at sundown took in sail and left to the wind
headed north north west thru the night
so ends

Remarks on board Friday January the 28th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze and
pleasant weather set all sail and left off
west north west nothing going on with remark
latitude 7.34 longitude 214.5 of sanderson took
in sail steady west north west thru the
night so ends this day

Remarks on board Saturday January the 29th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze and
pleasant weather took the waist boat in on
deck and made her at twelve o'clock set the
mainsail latitude 7.44 longitude 21.48 at four
o'clock raised sail on board and got her
out again at sundown took in sail
steady north west thru the night with
a fine breeze and good weather so ends this day

Remarks on board Sunday January the 30th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze and
thick and smoky weather set the mainsail
latitude 8.43 longitude 32.26 at five o'clock saw
a sail off the lee bow heading to the west
steady north west thru the day at sundown
took in sail steady north west thru the
night with a strong breeze and rugged weather
so ends

Remarks on board Monday January the 31st 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze and
rugged weather saw a shoal of blackfish but
did not hear latitude 10.2 longitude 34.48
steady north west thru the day at sundown

Took in the mainsail steady north west
thru the night with a strong breeze and
rugged weather so ends this day

Remarks on board Tuesday February the 1st 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze and
rugged weather set the mainsail nothing going
on with remark latitude 10.4 longitude 37.25
at one o'clock took in the mainsail
steady north west until sundown then took
in sail and left to the wind heading
north thru the night with a strong breeze
and rugged weather so ends this day

Remarks on board Wednesday February the 2nd 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze and
rugged weather left off before the wind stead
north west by west saw a Brig steering to
the west latitude 12.57 longitude 38.11
this afternoon broke out for water
and provisions at sundown left to the
wind to the northward heading north
thru the night with a strong breeze and
rugged weather

Remarks on board Thursday February the 3rd 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
and rugged weather stood no mast heads
this day latitude 13.44 longitude 38.44 at four
o'clock were round to the southward heading
steady south east thru the night with a
strong breeze and a heavy sea running so
ends

Remarks on board Friday February the 4th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
and thick smoky weather until a heavy
sea running left off steady south west
