This day commenced with a strong breeze
and raised rather hazy. Lat 44.44
stood no mast heads this day
steady south west by west thro the night
with a strong breeze and a heavy swell running
in ends

Remarks on board Sunday February the 6th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
from north east and thick smoke with
saw a Brig steering north west saw
suffer bottoms and a few fish lat 44.44
long 74.49 continued to blow
strong thro the day at sundown look
in the foretop sail and left to the wind
drifted south east by east thro the night
with a strong breeze and raised rather smooth

Remarks on board Monday February the 7th 1859

This day commenced with a moderate gale
from east north east and thick and rainy
weather saw a barge steering to the westward
in latitude and longitude continued to blow thro
the day and rain stood no mast heads
at six o'clock were ship headed north
west by north thro the night with
rainy weather and a strong breeze

Remarks on board Tuesday February the 8th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
from north east and rainy weather saw
foretop sail and left off south west to south west

Latitude and longitude had light squalls
off rain thro the day at sundown left
to the wind heading north west by north
thro the night with a strong breeze and rain
with smooth this day

Remarks on board Wednesday February the 9th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
and steady weather left off west latitude
44.54 longitude 74.54 at one o'clock were
saw and steady south saw foretop nothing
going on with remark at six o'clock left off
up south west had a strong breeze thro the night
smooth this day

Remarks on board Thursday February the 10th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
from north east and steady weather turned the
reef out of the foretop sail nothing going
on with remark latitude 44.54 longitude 74.54 at
six o'clock reefed the foretop sail left off west
had a heavy sea running had a strong breeze
thro the night and steady weather smooth

Remarks on board Friday February the 11th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze and
steady weather reefed the mainsail and jib
saw foretop sail latitude 44.54 longitude 74.54
nothing going on with remark at sundown
look in foretop sail and left off west north west
had a strong breeze thro the night smooth
