Remarks on board Sunday February the 20th 1859

This day commenced with fine weather at nine o'clock got under way and stood to sea to the southwest bound for St. Castalia at sundown was off the island of St. George saw kites and several sails set half watches had fine weather thru the night and good weather so ends this day

Remarks on board Monday February the 21st 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze and good weather at eight o'clock came to anchor at St. Castalia one watch got under way and went on shore the other board employed setting up and taking down rigging at sundown half of the watch came on board had fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday February the 22nd 1859

This day commenced with fine weather the remainder of the watch came on board and the other watch went on shore watch on board employed setting up and taking down rigging this afternoon got off the yards and potatoes and slide them away at six o'clock part of the watch came on board had fine weather thru the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Wednesday February the 23rd 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north east and pleasant weather at six o'clock the remainder of the watch came on board took a boy from shore to get the voice at eight o'clock took the anchor and stood to sea steamed west thru the day at half watches had fine weather thru the night so ends

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Remarks on board Thursday February the 24th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from the east and pleasant weather saw the island of Santa Cruz to the northward of us latitude 17.26 longitude 66.26 this afternoon saw the island of Portorico at sundown reefed the four topsail steamed to the westward thru the day at half watches came to the wind to the southward at one o'clock were mane to the southward fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Friday February the 25th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from the east and good weather left off before the wind latitud 17.25 longitude 66.25 at two o'clock left up for the land at five o'clock came to anchor at San Juan Chas came in here to paint ship had fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Saturday February the 26th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from the east and turned up the two greater boats and painted them a boats crew went on shore to get timecrivity saw several sails beating up to Portorico had so much swell heavy in that could not paint had fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Sunday February the 27th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from the north east and pleasant weather at eight o'clock took the anchor and stood to sea steamed to the westward thru the day saw humpbacks at sundown took in sail and kept to the wind to the southward at six o'clock were mane to the northward had a strong breeze thru the night so ends
