A fine west south west breeze the night with a fine breeze and pleasant weather so ends

Remarks on board Monday March the 7th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from the eastward and pleasant weather made sail nothing going on with remark this forenoon this afternoon men employed breaking out for provisions and water stowed west there the day at sundown took in sail and left to the wind head at south at two o'clock were round to the northward so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 8th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from the eastward made sail and left off to the westward at four o'clock at four o'clock the wind to the southward at five o'clock raised two sperm whales to the windward the whales off going with to the windward and away and pulled for them but did not get up with them at seven came on board had a strong breeze the fore part of the night latter part light breezes and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 9th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from the eastward and pleasant weather made sail and stood in shore the land saw blackfish nothing going on with remark at four o'clock took a ship and stood off shore at six took in sail had a light breeze thru the night and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Thursday March the 10th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from the southward and eastward fine blackfish and grampuss but did not see saw three sails had a light breeze thru the day and fine weather at sundown took in the light sails for part of the night calm latter part strong breezes so ends evening off same day

Remarks on board Friday March the 11th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze and good weather at the night sails at nine o'clock did away calm broke out for water at three o'clock got a breeze again from the southward and eastward saw a Barge to the westward of us at sundown took in sail and stood off shore had a strong breeze thru the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Saturday March the 12th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from the eastward took a ship and stood in shore at nine o'clock the wind did away some made sail saw humpbacks middle of the day light breezes and calm at three o'clock breezes strong again at sundown took in sail and stood off shore nothing going on with remark had a strong breeze thru the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Sunday March the 13th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from the eastward took a ship and stood in shore at nine o'clock wind did away some made sail middle of the day light breezes at four o'clock Captain Robinson came in board
