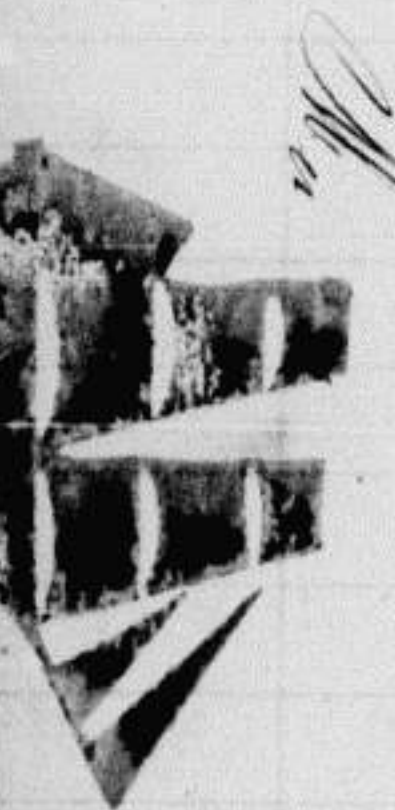

Remarks on board Monday March the 21st 1859

This day commenset with a fine breeze from the eastward made sail and left off to the westward went to work minding the blower at ten o'clock commenset haling latitude 19.42 longitude 77.44 this afternoon strong breeze and several sails shoving to the westward at five o'clock got three haling and cold down and washed off at six took in sail and left out with west had a strong breeze thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday March the 22nd 1859



This day commenset with a strong breeze from the eastward and rapid weather made sail and commenset haling out for water and shoe down oil latitude 18.18 and longitude 80.18 nothing going on with remark this afternoon shoud to the westward all this day at six o'clock took in sail and left to the wind to the southward had a light breeze thru the night so ends this day

Remarks on board Wednesday March the 23rd 1859

This day commenset with a light breeze from the eastward and fine weather made sail and left off to the westward at ten o'clock raised the Grand Cannons at one o'clock a boat came

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Along side got one barrel of her at six o'clock took in the light sails shoud out by scath three the day and west by north thru the night with a light breeze and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Thursday March the 24th 1859

This day commenset with a light breeze from the eastward and fine weather set all sail nothing going on with remark latitude 19.42 longitude 83.04 shoud out north west thru the day at sundown took in the light sails shoud north west by west thru the night with a light breeze and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Friday March the 25th 1859

This day commenset with a light breeze from the southward and pleasant weather men employed a sailing down the fore and main rigging all this day latitude 21.14 longitude 88.29 shoud west north west thru the day at sundown took in the light sails had it calm thru the night had down the main sail so ends

Remarks on board Saturday March the 26th 1859

This day commenset with finer weather but warm at seven o'clock commenset rattling down again latitude 21.12 longitude 88.44 this afternoon broke out for water and met a moderate calm thru the day at six o'clock had a little air from the eastward shoud west thru the night with a light breeze so ends

Remarks on board Sunday March the 27th 1859

This day commenset with a fine breeze from south east and pleasant weather made sail and left off north west at ten o'clock past the south west Point off Cuba saw a large ship ashore on the reef so ends
