Remarks on board Saturday April the 9th 1858

This day commenset with a light breeze from the eastward and fine weather, set all sail and tack'd ship to the northward gave four ships steering to the southward by the wind. Lat^{td} 27.40 Long^{td} 88.40 broke out five four this afternoon at four o'clock tack'd ship to the southward at six o'clock took in the light sails at eight o'clock tack'd ship again head'd east north east three the night with a light breeze and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Sunday April the 10th 1858

This day commenset with a fine breeze from the eastward and good weather set all sail Lat^{td} 28.08 Long^{td} 87.37 saw two sails this afternoon steering north west at four o'clock tack'd ship head'd south west at six o'clock took in the light sails head'd to the southward and westward until two o'clock then tack'd to the southward light breeze so ends

Remarks on board Monday April the 11th 1858

This day commenset with a fine breeze from the southward set all sail and tack'd ship to the southward and westward look'd out for water Lat^{td} 27.35 Long^{td} 88.24 at two o'clock tack'd ship to the eastward again. Catch'd two porpoises at half past six o'clock took in the light sails head'd to the eastward three the night with a fine breeze and good weather so ends this day



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Remarks on board Tuesday April the 12th 1858

This day commenset with a fine breeze from south east and good weather at seven o'clock tack'd ship to the southward and westward Lat^{td} 27.25 Long^{td} 87.20 this afternoon head'd on strong at six o'clock took in sail head'd to the southward and westward three the night at five o'clock took in the fore topsail being a gail so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 13th 1858

This day commenset with a moderate gail from south east and good weather at seven o'clock were head'd to the eastward Lat^{td} 27.00 Long^{td} 87.30 this afternoon had it a little more moderate at four o'clock were run again head'd south west till half of the night light breeze and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Thursday April the 14th 1858

This day commenset with a fine breeze from the southward made sail and were run to the eastward saw two sails steering to the northward and on to the southward at one o'clock tow'd the waist boat and pick'd up a vessel govt saw five backs Lat^{td} 27.06 and Long^{td} 87.00 had it calm three the night so ends

Remarks on board Friday April the 15th 1858

This day commenset with a fine breeze from south east and pleasant weather set all sail and tack'd ship to the southward nothing going on worth remark Lat^{td} 26.15 Long^{td} 85.26 at sundown took in sail head'd north west four part of the night fine
