Remarks on board Monday May the 9th 1859

This day commenset with a fine breeze from east south east and good weather made sail and lashed ship to the scullard latitude 28° 56' longitude 78° 33' at one o'clock saw a black fish and lard for them the wait boat got on the barque boat shad one but dead from here at two o'clock came on board and handed the black fish in and reala hie off saw several sails showing to the northward at sundown took in sail and were round to the northward and caplana had it rany thru the night and thunder and lightning so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 10th 1859

This day commenset with a light breeze from east south east and rany weather made sail and were round to the scullard at eight o'clock cleared off men employed minding up the blader latitude 28° 26' longitude 78° 32' at two o'clock the wind hadle round south lashed ship headed south east by east at sundown took in sail had a strong breeze thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 11th 1859

This day commenset with a fine breeze from south west and good weather set all sail at seven o'clock commenset heeling out the black fish at ten got three and cold down latitude 28° 50' longitude 78° 41' saw green peris at five o'clock dide away from at sundown took in sail and lashed ship thru the night so ends this day

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Remarks on board Thursday May the 12th 1859

This day commenset with a light breeze from north east and good weather set all sail broke out for water men employed clearing men work and sailing up and sailing down the bar lashed ship reging latitude 28° 47' longitude 78° 50' signed south south west thru the day at sundown took in sail and left to the wind headed north west by north at two o'clock were round headed south east so ends this day

Remarks on board Friday May the 13th 1859

This day commenset with a fine breeze from north north east made sail and left off south south west men employed cleaning and painting iron work latitude 28° 40' longitude 78° 30' at one o'clock left off west by south at four o'clock heeled up the yards and left to the wind headed north west by north at sundown took in sail at two o'clock were round to the eastern fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Saturday May the 14th 1859

This day commenset with a fine breeze from north north east and good weather made sail and left off south east by south commenset heeling out for pumps at eleven o'clock got thru and rode down latitude 27° 30' longitude 78° 56' at one o'clock left to the wind to the eastward at two o'clock lashed ship headed north west at four o'clock lashed to the eastward again at sundown took in sail and were round headed north west at three o'clock were round to the eastward so ends
