Remarks on board Sunday May 15th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from north east and clear weather made sail and set all sail and left off north east men employed setting up the topgallant rigging saw a sail showing north east by east latitude 29.20 long 104.45 at sundown look in sail and left to the wind headed east north east then the night so ends

Remarks on board Monday May 16th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze and clear weather made sail and looked ship to the eastward nothing going in north remark at ten o'clock looked ship again headed north west by north latitude 27.46 long 104.22 at sundown look in sail had a strong breeze the fore part of the night latter part light breeze and good weather so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday May 17th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and good weather made sail and looked ship to the southward and eastward saw three sails heading to the westward by the wind at ten o'clock looked ship again in wind hauled round to the eastward latitude 28.30 long 104.45 had a light breeze then the day at sundown look in sail had a light breeze then the night and fine weather so ends

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Remarks on board Wednesday May 18th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south south east and good weather set all sail and left off north east men employed setting up the topgallant rigging saw a sail showing north east by east latitude 29.20 long 104.45 at sundown look in sail and left to the wind headed east north east then the night so ends

Remarks on board Thursday May 19th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south south east and good weather made sail and left off north east proceeded for water latitude 30.00 long 104.50 saw three Schooners heading south and eastward by the wind at sundown look in sail and left to the wind headed east by south at one o'clock were round to the westward so ends

Remarks on board Friday May 20th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from south south east and clear weather made sail and left off north west saw three sails showing to the eastward at ten o'clock were round and steamed north east latitude 30.20 long 104.25 at one o'clock left to the wind headed east nothing going on path remark at sundown look in sail had a strong breeze the fore part of the night at one o'clock were round to the westward with a fine breeze and good weather so ends
