Remarks on board Saturday May the 27th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south east and good weather made sail and took ship by the eastern breeze out for small stores. Latitude 34° 23' longitude 75° 02' nothing going on with remark at sundown took ship to the westward and took in sail saw a sail steering to the northward made in the western breeze the night so ends

Remarks on board Sunday May the 28th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from the southward had a squall of rain at six o'clock made sail and took a boat and picked up a cask took ship to the eastward latitude 34° 06' longitude 74° 50' saw comical and a sail to the westward of us steering to the eastward at two o'clock the breeze had a run south west set off south east at sundown took in sail had a light breeze from the night so ends

Remarks on board Monday May the 29th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from the southward and fine weather made sail at seven o'clock had a squall of rain and the wind had a run north west latitude 34° 20' longitude 75° 50' at three o'clock had a boat and galley some fish some a bird saw a sail steering to the southward and a steamer steering to the northward at sundown took in sail steam east then the day nothing going on with remark had a run the night so ends

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Remarks on board Tuesday May the 30th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from east north east and good weather with a heavy swell coming from the northward made sail and stood on to the southward and eastward latitude 34° 15' longitude 74° 01' this afternoon broke up for water and meat and then saw three sail steering to the southward and eastward at sundown took in sail had it raining the middle of the night had a fine good weather and a light breeze so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday May the 31st 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and fine weather set all sail and stood on to the southward and eastward saw two sails one steering north west and the other steering south latitude 34° 06' longitude 73° 13' nothing going on with remark at sundown took in sail made east south east had it calm most of the night so ends

Remarks on board Thursday May the 1st 1860

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and fine weather set all sail and stood on to the eastward latitude 34° 00' longitude 72° 00' saw several sails steering different courses nothing going on with remark at sundown took in sail had a light breeze from the night and fine weather making to the eastward so ends these twenty four hours
