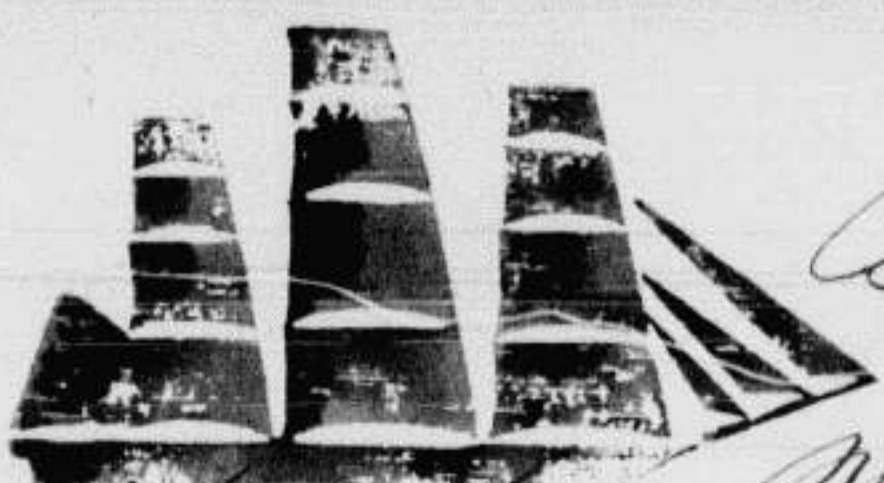




Brig Kate Carey

Remarks on board Very day May the 27th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east, and fine weather set all sail and stood on to the eastward. Saw three sails steering to the southward. Lat. 29.14 longitude 72.33 at two o'clock. Lacked ship headed north north west nothing going on with remark at sundown took in sail had it come the lower part of the night. Light breeze so ends.

Remarks on board Friday May the 28th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and fine weather set all sail men employed breaking out at ten o'clock. Lacked ship to the eastward. Lat. 29.15 longitude 72.40 saw several sails steering to the southward at sundown took in the light sails and kept the fore top sail had a light breeze thru the night and fine weather so ends.

Remarks on board Sunday May the 29th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north north east and good weather set sail and stood on to the eastward. Lat. 29.05 long. 72.21 saw nothing with remark at sundown took in the light sails at eight o'clock. Lacked ship headed north north west thru the night with a light breeze and good weather so ends.

Remarks on board Monday May the 30th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north east and good weather set all sail broke out for water and bread. Lat. 29.44 longitude 70.44 saw two sails on

Steering south and the other bearing east by the wind men employed a heeling down some crew line at sundown lacked ship and took in the light sails headed east north east had it come thru the night so ends.

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 31st 1859

This day commenced with fine weather but calm at eight o'clock got a breeze from east north east set all sail and stood to the northward. Lat. 30.20 longitude 71.29. This afternoon heaved on strong and at two o'clock took in the light sails saw two sails steering to the northward and the other to the southward at sundown took in sail had a light breeze thru the latter part of the night so ends.

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 1st 1859

This day commenced with fine weather but calm nothing going on with remark. Lat. 31.30 longitude 71.27 had it come thru the day saw a sail to the northward of us at sundown took in sail had it come thru the night so ends.

Remarks on board Thursday June the 2nd 1859

This day commenced with a fine weather but calm at nine o'clock got a breeze from south east set all sail and stood to the eastward. Lat. 32.15 longitude 70.20 saw three sails steering to the southward and nothing going on with remark at sundown took in the light sails headed east by north thru the night with a fine breeze and good weather so ends.
