Remarks on board Tuesday June the 3rd 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south-east by south set sail saw a Brig steering north-east nothing going on board remark latitude 33° 00' longitude 69° 34' this afternoon had a fresh breeze saw a Brig steering north at sundown took up anchor light sails at night vessel looked ship head south with them the night so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 4th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from south south-east and clear weather looked ship to the eastward took out for water this forenoon latitude 32° 54' longitude 69° 42' saw a sail a strong breeze at sundown took in sail had a strong breeze thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Sunday June the 5th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from south and rainy weather at ten o'clock set the mainsail and jib saw two sails steering north-west in latitude and longitude at four o'clock took in the jib and mainsail had a squall and the wind shifted and ran north-west at sundown did away came had it rain thru the night and calm so ends

Remarks on board Monday June the 6th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from south and good weather made sail and stood on to the southward and eastward latitude 32° 38'

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Longitude 69° 22' had a light breeze thru the day at seven o'clock set half-masted steam south-east by south thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 7th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north-west and fine weather left off east-south-east caught a breeze at eleven o'clock raised anchor the island of Bermuda was open for it latitude 32° 20' no land here this forenoon breeze fresh at four o'clock got ahead of the breeze at six o'clock took a pilot and beat up into the mouth of Georgetown harbor and came to anchor in the Bay of St. Michael's and a brig belonging to New York had fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 8th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze and fine weather got out the cage and went up to the town washers of the ship and got ready for painting this afternoon broke out and painted some and got off to hogt loads of wood at sundown looked at bark had fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Thursday June the 9th 1859

This day commenced with fine weather got ready and went to painting covered some cargo on shore and filled them with water got off some wood at one o'clock the bark was at anchor and went on shore to have a run round got the water off and close it away got the vessel painted some had fine weather thru the night so ends
