Remarks on board Friday June the 10th 1859

This day commenced with fine weather got off a boat, took a good deal of wood and unisins and potatoes this afternoon the lascar watch went in shore at six o'clock got things a little away and cleared up. Nocks had fine weather threw the night so ends.

Remarks on board Saturday June the 11th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze and fine weather at eight o'clock took the anchor and stood to sea had fine weather threw the day at sundown the lascar bore south west around ten miles took in the light sails hauled north east threw the sea. At the part of the night the wind hauled round north east so ends.

Remarks on board Sunday June the 12th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and fine weather. Steamed east south east latitude 32° 00' longitude 68° 00' saw porpoises. This afternoon had a light breeze threw the night and fine weather so ends.

Remarks on board Monday June the 13th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from east north east and good weather set all sail at seven o'clock. Lascar two boats for black pig but did not get any. They being very shy saw porpoises and grampas. Latitude 32° 00' longitude 68° 06' at four o'clock saw a sail to the southward of us heading to the eastward at sundown took in the light

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Sails steamed south east threw the day and night with fine weather so ends.

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 14th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from east and good weather set all sail at seven o'clock raised spouts to the windward thought that they were tobacco but the boats and hauled to the windward but saw nothing more of them from the boats or ship. At eleven came on board latitude 32° 16' longitude 68° 25' saw five sails this afternoon to stand to the westward and one to the southward and the other to the southward and eastward in the wind at four o'clock captured a porpoise at sundown took in sail at twelve o'clock hauled ship heading north east by north so ends.

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 15th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from east south east and fine weather set all sail at seven o'clock hauled ship heading south nothing going on with remark at ten o'clock hauled ship heading north east by east latitude 32° 00' longitude 68° 00' at one o'clock raised spout. At the other hauled five miles off at two o'clock had all three boats and pulled for them did not see but one after we had and could not get in to him thought he had been fast to before. Hauled him until dark then got him up and came on board took in the light sails heading to the eastward threw the night with a light breeze and fine weather so ends.
