Remarks on board Thursday June the 23rd 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from east south east and fine weather men employed overhauling and strapping blocks latitude 32.13, longitude 55.53 heading north east then the day at five o'clock had a squall of rain at sundown took in the light sails heading north east threw the night with a light breeze and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Friday June the 24th 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from east south east and fine weather set all sail nothing going on with wind around latitude 33.25 longitude 55.25 saw a Schooner steering to the southward and westward at sundown took in the light sails had it calm threw the night so ends

Remarks on board Saturday June the 25th 1859

This day commenced with fine weather but early saw a sail to the southward of us began to the eastward men employed in various ships duties latitude 33.39 longitude 55.25 at ten o'clock calm all this day at sundown took a boat and went on board of the *Burgue Edward* Boston of Liverpool William Master and got some papers she was bound to Liverpool latter part of the night got a breeze steam south east by east so ends

Remarks on board Sunday June the 26th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south east and good weather set all sail saw a sail steering to the southward by the wind

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Latitude 33.35 longitude 54.00 saw a fish this afternoon steam south east threw the day at sundown took in the light sails had a fine breeze threw the night so ends

Remarks on board Monday June the 27th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south south east and fine weather set all sail men employed making out for water and provisions latitude 32.36 longitude 52.20 this afternoon employed in the rigging saw a sail to the northward of us heading to the southward and westward at sundown took in the light sails had a light breeze threw the night and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 28th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south east and fine weather set all sail saw a Brig heading to the westward nothing going on with wind around latitude 33.40 longitude 51.25 at two o'clock tackled ship heading south south west saw a small ship heading to the eastward at sundown took in the light sails at twelve o'clock hooked ship to the eastward had fine weather threw the night so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday June the 29th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from south south east and fine weather set all sail and hooked ship to the southward and westward at six o'clock raised blackfish and had for them and the harbor boat got on at half past seven came on board and held the blubber off came on board at latitude 32.22 longitude 57.41
