Remarks on board Wednesday August the 10th 1857

This day commenced with a light breeze from
 south east and fine weather made sail and
 commenced steering down reached a harbor
 latitude 31.35 longitude 49.29 at two o'clock
 got there steering down and washed off the
 ship at sundown took in sail heading
 to the eastward thru the day had fine
 weather thru the night and a light breeze
 so ends

Remarks on board Thursday August the 11th 1857

This day commenced with a light breeze from
 the eastward and good weather set all sail took
 the main boat in in deed and commenced
 repairing it saw grasshoppers latitude 32.09
 no longitude at three o'clock taken ship to
 the southward and eastward at sundown took
 in sail had it calm rest of the night
 so ends

Remarks on board Friday August the 12th 1857

This day commenced with a light breeze from
 south east and fine weather made sail and
 commenced repairing the main boat again
 no latitude and longitude saw grasshoppers
 at sundown took in sail heading to the
 eastward had fine weather thru the night
 and a light breeze so ends

Remarks on board Saturday August the 13th 1857

This day commenced with a light breeze from
 from the southward and fine weather made
 sail and stood on to the eastward at
 four o'clock got there with the main boat
 and got her in the repairs again latitude
 31.49 no longitude this after noon repaired
 the starboard boat and then damaged at
 sundown took in sail had a light
 breeze and fine weather thru the night so ends

Remarks on board Sunday August the 14th 1857

This day commenced with a fine breeze
 from the southward and fine weather made
 sail and stood on to the eastward
 latitude 32.50 longitude 47.55 saw nothing
 with remark at sundown took in
 sail had a light breeze thru the night
 and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Monday August the 15th 1857

This day commenced with a light breeze from
 the southward and fine weather made sail
 and stood on to the eastward repaired
 the harbor boat saw a ship steering
 north east under all sail latitude 33.12
 longitude 45.40 at water at sundown
 took in sail had it calm thru the
 night so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday August the 16th 1857

This day commenced with light air from
 the southward set all sail and stood on
 to the eastward saw employes taring down
 saw the sails on steering north east
 and the other east latitude 33.30
