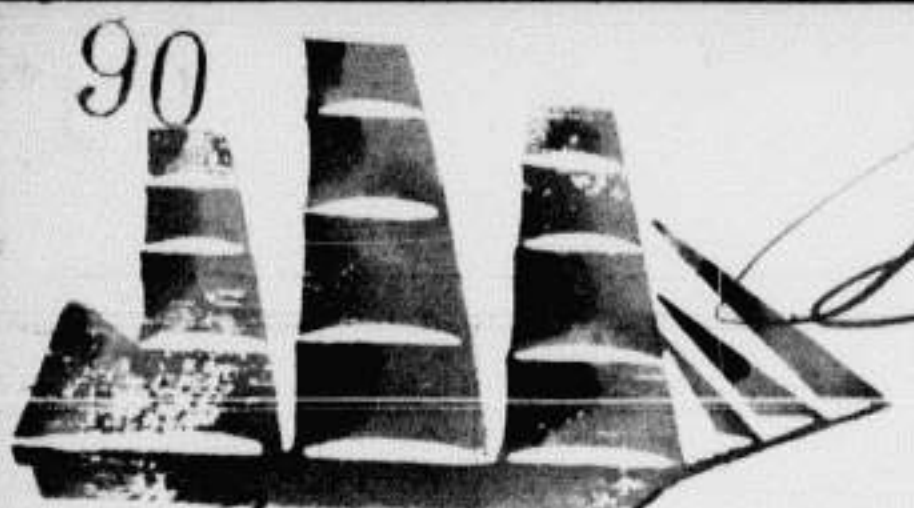




Brig Kate Cary

Remarks on board Thursday September the 29th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from the eastward and fine weather made sail and several sails standing to the southward and eastward under all sail latitude 30.48 longitude 17.30 watch employed in various ships duty steam south south east then the day passed quiet till it squally the latter part of the night so ends

Remarks on board Friday September the 30th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north east and good weather ship heading east south east by the wire nothing going on with remark latitude 29.48 longitude 18.31 saw a ship standing to the southward under all sail had a fine breeze then the day ends

Remarks on board Saturday October the 1st 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from east north east and a foggy weather at two o'clock made a head the stand off Lantzport the watch employed in organizing ships duty latitude 29.22 longitude 19.00 at five o'clock got in under the land looked ship came stood off shore to the northward at sundown took in sail had a fresh breeze the fore part of the night latter part light breeze and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Sunday October the 2nd 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from north east and fine weather

Under sail and stood in shore had fine weather from the day causing off Lantzport the north side saw a whaling Barge to the windward of us at sundown took in sail had light air then the night and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Monday October the 3rd 1859

This day commenced with a light breeze from the northward and fine weather made sail and stood to the eastward saw two sails heading to the eastward the watch employed making in the rigging had it calm the middle of the day at one o'clock came the wind head and caught a north at two o'clock got a light breeze from the northward steam east south east at sunset took in sail and left to the wind off the north point of Lantzport had a light breeze then the night and fine weather so ends

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 4th 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north east and fine weather got all sail the watch employed making at looked ship several times to fetch round the land at two o'clock stood past the north east point of Lantzport and off to the southward saw a whaling Barge to the windward of us at sundown took in sail and left to the wind to the eastward at two o'clock saw ship to the westward had a fresh breeze then the night so ends
