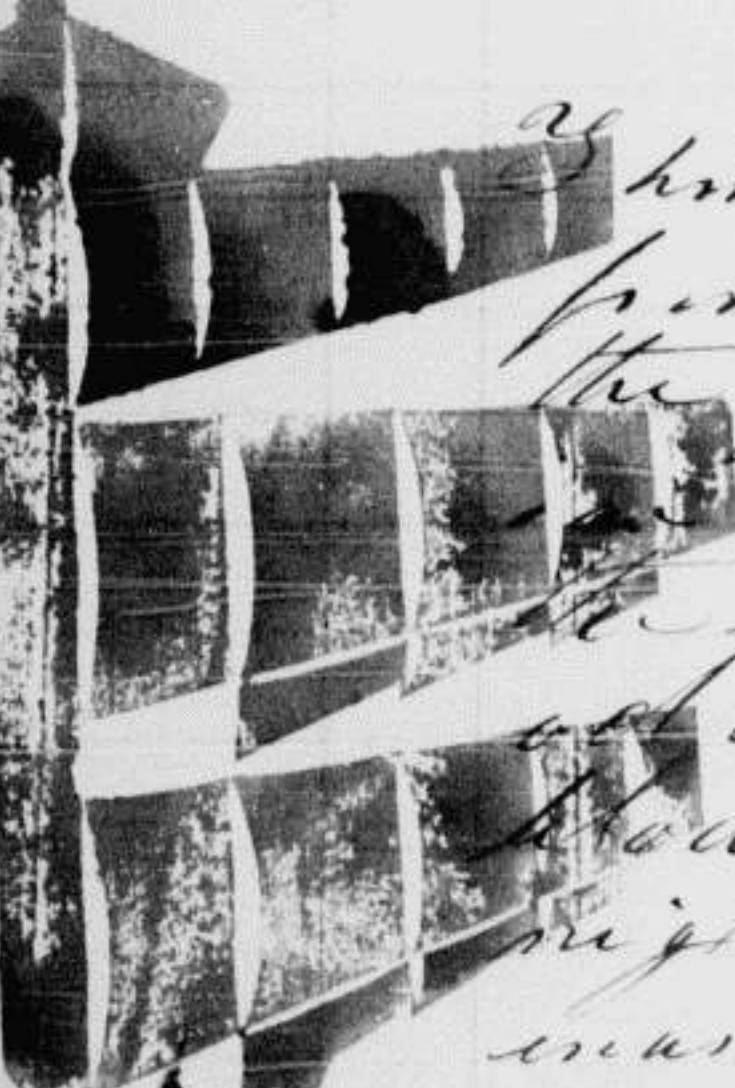

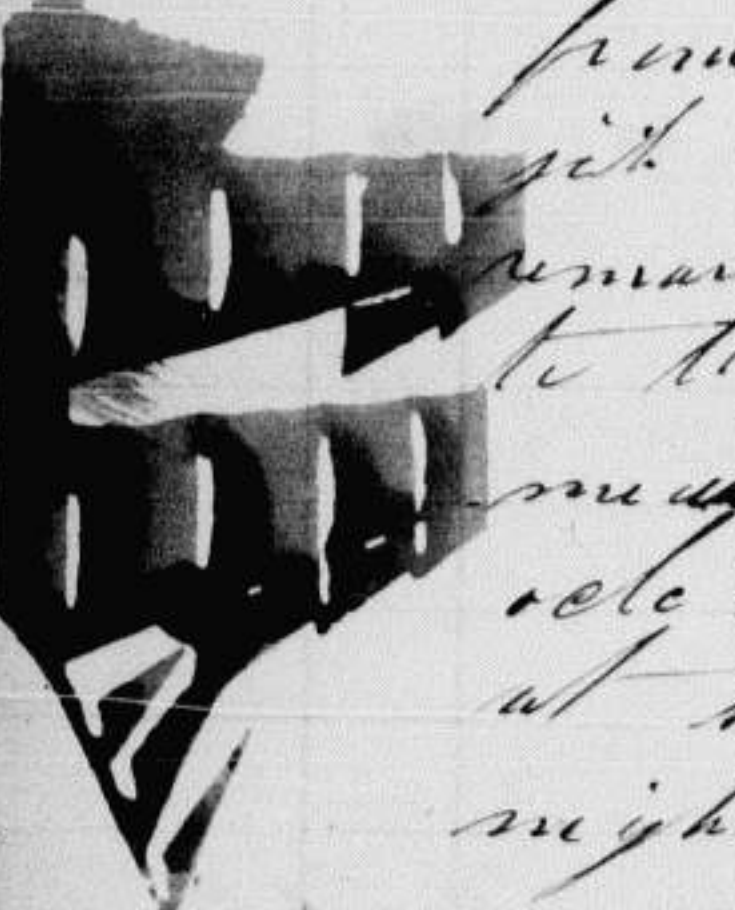
the breeze veered to the westward

Remarks on board Sunday October the 23rd 1859



This day commenced with a strong breeze
from the northward and raised rather at
the jib and mainsail saw grasshopper
the Merchant ships steering to
the southward under all sail at four
o'clock took in the jib and mainsail
hoisted on strong to the fore part of the
night tiller part masted down as
ends off tanna reef

Remarks on board Monday October the 24th 1859



This day commenced with a light breeze
from north east and good weather at the
jib and mainsail nothing going on with
unmaking saw several Merchant vessels steering
to the southward near all sail saw grasshopper
middle of the day had it calm at three
o'clock got a light breeze from the eastward
at sundown took in sail tiller part of the
night had it calm so ends

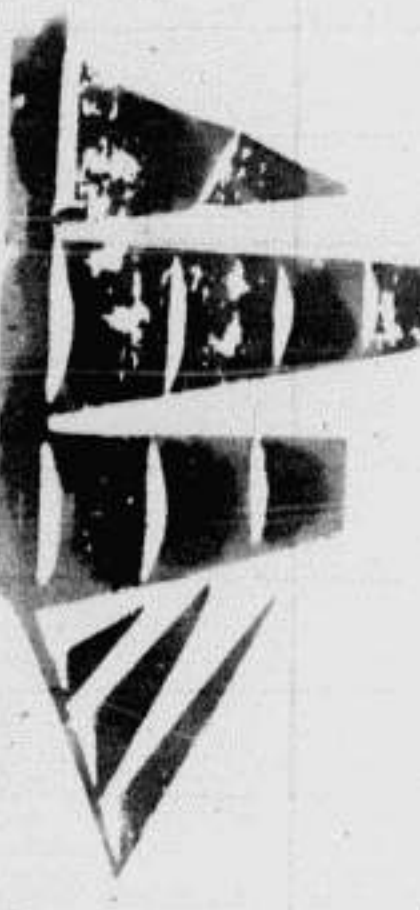
Remarks on board Tuesday October the 25th 1859



This day commenced with a light breeze
from the northward light off south saw
the Merchant vessels steering south west
under all sail watch employed seeing up
rigging all this day saw grasshopper at
sundown took in sail tiller 26.50
length the 55 had a light breeze
thru the night steered to the southward
all these twenty four hours so ends

Remarks on board Wednesday October the 26th 1859



This day commenced with a fine breeze
from north east and fine weather at
all sail the watch employed working
on the rigging tiller 26.50 length the
55 saw a Merchant Brig steering
south west under all sail saw a fine
breeze at sundown took in sail had
a fine breeze thru the night so ends
steered south south west all these twenty
four hours

Remarks on board Thursday October the 27th 1859



This day commenced with a fresh breeze
from north east and clear weather
made sail at ten o'clock catch a breeze
tiller 24.00 length the 80 watch
employed breaking out for small steers
at sundown took in sail had a
strong breeze thru the night so ends steered
south west all these twenty four hours

Remarks on board Friday October the 28th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze
from north east and thick smoky weather
the watch employed in ordinary ship
duties tiller 22.15 length the 29 steered
south west all this day saw nothing with
unmaking had a strong breeze thru the
night and raised rather steering
south west so ends
