Smother, rather at sight of her raised a broad ahead stand for it but saw nothing more watch employed in chasing ship's duty. Latitude 21° 02' long 151° 50' clear south west from the day at sundown look in suit and left to the wind to the northward and motion had a strong breeze from the night scenes

Remarks on board Sunday October the 30th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from north east and thick smother rather light off west saw a Brig sharing south west under all sail latitude 19° 28' longitude 151° 21' at one o'clock left off south south west saw grasshoppers at sundown look in suit and left to the wind heading south west the four part of the night better part were round and heading north west had it more moderate scenes

Remarks on board Monday October the 31st 1859

This day commenced with a fresh breeze and thick rather more sail and left off west the watch employed in various ship's duty at ten o'clock were ship and heading to the southward and eastward by the wind latitude 18° 45' longitude 151° 52' saw a ship steering South west under all sail at sundown look in suit had a strong breeze from the night heading to the southward and eastward scenes

Remarks on board Tuesday November the 1st 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from north east and clear weather turned the rest out of the low

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Light rain off south watch employed in ordinary ship's duty saw fire boats latitude 17° 50' longitude 151° 40' at one o'clock left off south south east had a strong breeze from the day at sundown look in suit and left to the wind heading east south east had a strong breeze from the night scenes

Remarks on board Wednesday November the 2nd 1859

This day commenced with a fresh breeze from north east and clear weather turned out the rest and saw none and clear south west watch employed making out for fairways latitude 17° 04' longitude 151° 17' this afternoon had a fine breeze and good weather saw grasshoppers at sundown look in suit and left to the wind heading north west the four part of the night better part to the eastward had fine weather scenes

Remarks on board Thursday November the 3rd 1859

This day commenced with a fine breeze from north east and good weather more sail and left off south by west the watch employed in ordinary ship's duty latitude 16° 25' longitude 151° 44' at one o'clock were round and clear south east had fine weather from the day at six o'clock were round and steering south south west better part of the night had a fresh breeze scenes

Remarks on board Friday November the 4th 1859

This day commenced with a strong breeze from north east and clear weather
