This day commenced with fine breeze from  
north east and good weather at all sail  
sailed about on to the northeast and outward  
saw a Brig sailing to the southwest saw  
pink oak bottom built length 23 1/2 ft this  
afternoon had fresh breeze the watch employed  
in raising ship's planks at sundown took  
in sail ship heaving north out by the  
wind had fresh breeze than the night So  
ends

Remarks on board Saturday January the 21st 1860

This day commenced with strong breeze from  
north east and good weather made sail  
and steered north out by north the watch  
employed heaving out for water saw pink oak  
bottom built length 24 1/2 ft had strong  
breeze from the day at sundown took  
in sail and left off sail north west  
had strong breeze than the night and  
good weather steaming out north west So  
ends

Remarks on board Sunday January the 22nd 1860

This day commenced with strong breeze from  
north east and good weather turned the  
watch out of the foretop sail pink oak  
saw one sail westward of us bottom built  
length 26 1/2 ft had strong breeze than  
the day saw blackfish but did not hear for  
them at sundown raised the foretop sail  
had strong breeze than the night and  
good weather So ends

This day commenced with strong breeze from  
north east and thick smoky weather made  
sail saw a ship steaming north west  
under all sail the watch employed in  
raising ship's planks bottom built length 26 1/2 ft  
had strong breeze than the day at sundown took  
in sail ship heaving north out by the  
wind had strong breeze than the night So ends

Remarks on board Wednesday January the 25th 1860

This day commenced with strong breeze  
from north east and thick smoky weather  
made sail the watch employed heaving  
out for water and provisions bottom built  
length 32 1/2 ft saw a ship steaming  
to the southwest under all sail had strong  
breeze than the day at sundown took in  
sail ship heaving north out by the  
wind had strong breeze than the night So ends
