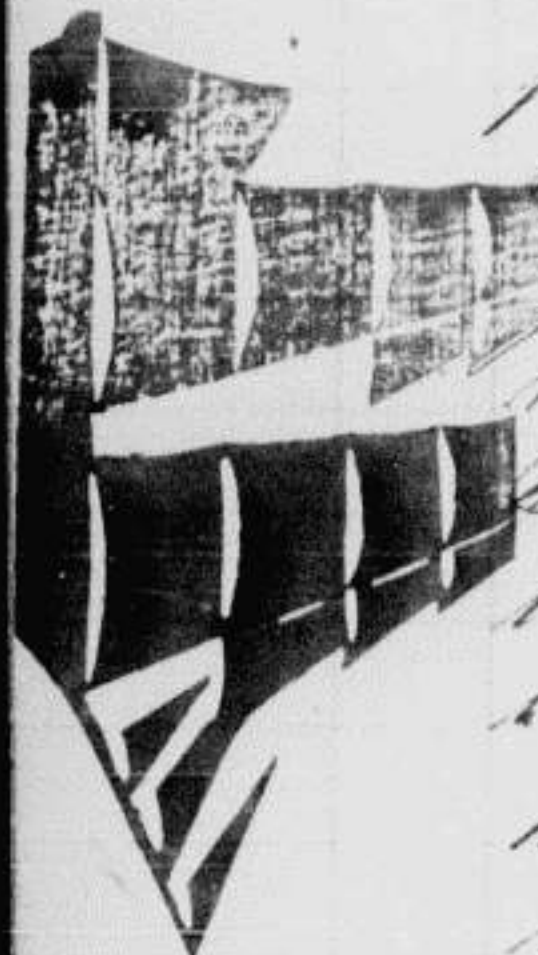


Brig Kate Cory

 took in sail showing with west had
 strong breeze from the night So ends

Remarks on board Friday January the 27th 1860



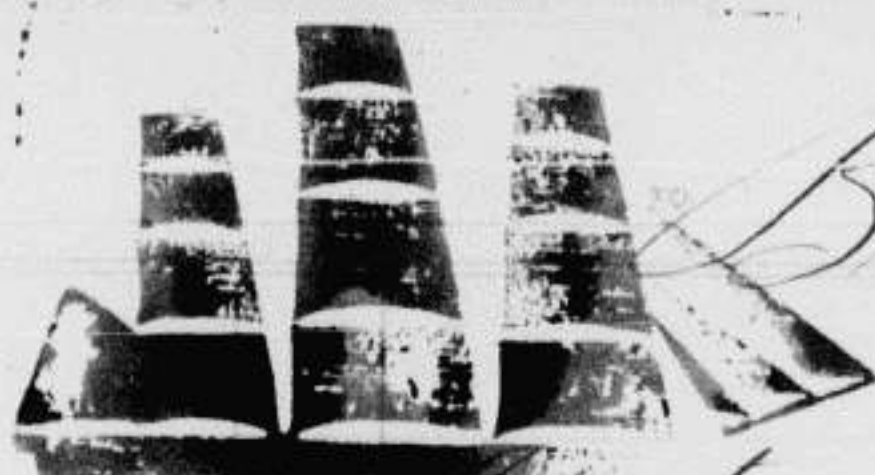
This day commenced with strong breeze
 from north east and raged with force
 the ship at 4 the first part nothing
 going in more than ordinary state
 latitude 44 longitude 35.25 saw a
 ship steering to the northward had
 strong breeze from the day steered north
 west at sundown sail up the foremast
 and furler it and left to the wind
 headed with had strong breeze from
 the night So ends

Remarks on board Saturday January the 28th 1860

This day commenced with a moderate
 gale from north east and fresh and
 raged with force latitude 42.57 longitude 32.05
 had strong breeze from the day ship being
 two heading to the northward steered
 no small breeze this day had it raged
 the first part of the night with thunder and
 lightning latter part had it more moderate
 So ends

Remarks on board Sunday January the 29th 1860

This day commenced with strong breeze
 from north east and raged with force
 the most breeze at noon and at night

On to a gale could the men down from
 ship latitude 40.40 longitude 39.53 saw a
 large ship heading to the northward
 at sundown had it more moderate
 ship being two heading to the northward
 had strong breeze from the night and
 raged with force So ends

Remarks on board Monday January the 30th 1860

This day commenced with strong breeze
 from north east and raged with force the
 foremast and was ship and steered north
 west the watch employed heading out
 for water at ten o'clock bore the reef
 out of the topmast had it more moderate
 latitude 40.18 longitude 40.27 steered
 north west then the day at sundown
 took in sail and left to the wind
 to the northward had strong breeze
 from the night and raged with force So ends

Remarks on board Tuesday January the 31st 1860

This day commenced with strong breeze
 from north east and raged with force
 off north west the watch employed in
 ordinary state latitude 42.50
 longitude 41.22 at two o'clock were
 raged and steered north west had strong
 breeze from the day at sundown left
 with north west had strong breeze
 from the night and raged with force
 So ends

Remarks on board Wednesday February the 1st 1860

This day commenced with strong
 breeze from north east and raged
 with force the first part of the night
