Remarks on board Monday April the 2nd 1860

This day commenced with light breeze
from the southward and eastward made
sail and stood on to the northward
saw a Brig lying at anchor off Alaska
saw grampies the watch employed breaking
out by head at ten o'clock hauled ship
and stood north had light breeze
then the day at sundown took in
sail had it calm then the night
So ends off Sam day

Remarks on board Tuesday April the 3rd 1860

This day commenced with light breeze
from the southward and good weather made
sail and stand on to the northward
the watch employed in ordinary ship's duties
saw large quantities of grampies catch
a few had light breeze then the day
few Whales in sight at sundown
took in sail and were round and
head off shore to the southward
had light breeze then the night So
ends off Sam day

Remarks on board Wednesday April the 4th 1860

This day commenced with light breeze
from the northward and good weather
made sail and stood on to the southward

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This watch employed in ordinary ship's
duties few Whales in sight had light
breeze then the day at sundown
took in sail had it calm then
part of the night got a light breeze
from the southward So ends off Sam day

Remarks on board Thursday April the 5th 1860

This day commenced with light breeze
from the northward and good weather
made sail and stood on to the
southward high water and heavy
then Whales in sight at sundown
got a fresh breeze from the eastward
left off before the wind and stand west
at sundown took in the mainsail
had it calm the fore part of the night
batter part stand off standing west by north
So ends

Remarks on board Friday April the 6th 1860

This day commenced with fresh breeze
from the eastward and good weather
the watch employed making up the main
sailing bottom 13m 22 1/2
had fine weather then the day at
sundown left off with light
breeze then the night So ends off the
south west part of St. Domingo

Remarks on board Saturday April the 7th 1860

This day commenced with light breeze
from the northward and good weather
made sail and stood on to the southward
at ten o'clock dice away calm
bottom 13m 18 1/2 length 44 1/2 the
