Remarks on hand Sunday August the 11th 1860

Commenced with light breeze from the northward and fine weather the watch employed getting only water and washing off the deck ~~fine~~ ^{only} side bottom 39, 40, 41 lengthen 43, 25 the sea somewhat rough, clearing distant coasts at this point side away, calm at four o'clock got a light breeze from the northward clearing north east at six o'clock scattered and found twenty fathom. And light breeze the fore part of the night latter part fine breeze clearing north east. It ends

Remarks on board Saturday August the 15th 1860

Comment with fire beams from rock
west and good weather took in the
main sail to keep it from slaking to
pieces saw two ships and a number of
schooners between 400 20 30 length
120 20 W the watch employed clearing
out the boats at one o'clock raised
Lenny Island off the barbed beam
and hoist half up east with east
at five o'clock got up the cables and bent
them and got one anchor clear at seven
o'clock raised the light on Montauk
point later part of the night vice
away calm and came in thick foggy
So ends these twenty four hours

Remarks on board Sunday August - the 19th 1860

Commenced with light breezes from the eastward and thick fog at seven o'clock lighted up our Black Island and the boat set all sail and stood in for without saw about twenty sails of vessels at twelve o'clock off ~~show~~ but had it calm at four o'clock got a fresh breeze from east north east stood in off Second point and looked ship back in the fore topgallant and main topsail set a signal for a pilot at sundown back in sail and stood off and in three the night had thick weather So ended

Remarks in Board Monday August the 20th 1860

Comment with five hours and a day
with out all suit and stood in
for after that at six o'clock got a
pilot and hauled aboard waiting for the
tide at ten o'clock went forward
and stood in to the harbor beat
up the river and at half past
seven got along side of the wharf
So was the night

The shot and shell went flying and the rebel
cannons roar and we fought against Jefferson
Davis in a gantoo man of war
