Remarks on board Saturday May the 11th 1861

Commenced with fresh breezes from north west and fair weather the watch employed in ordinary ships duty at four o'clock P.M. raised land the island of Belmore some fifty miles off the weather bore steered east south east thru the night saw firebacks the watch employed patrolling in chasing gear catches a porpoise latter part fresh breezes So ends latter 85 40 longitude

Remarks on board Sunday May the 12th 1861

Commenced with fresh breezes from the westward and fair weather saw firebacks at four P.M. raised Bengal having south by east some twenty miles off at sundown took in sail and left to the wind to the northward at Beale's Creek watch headed to the northward thru the night at daylight made sail and left off east by south latter part light breezes off Greece So ends

Remarks on board Monday May the 13th 1861

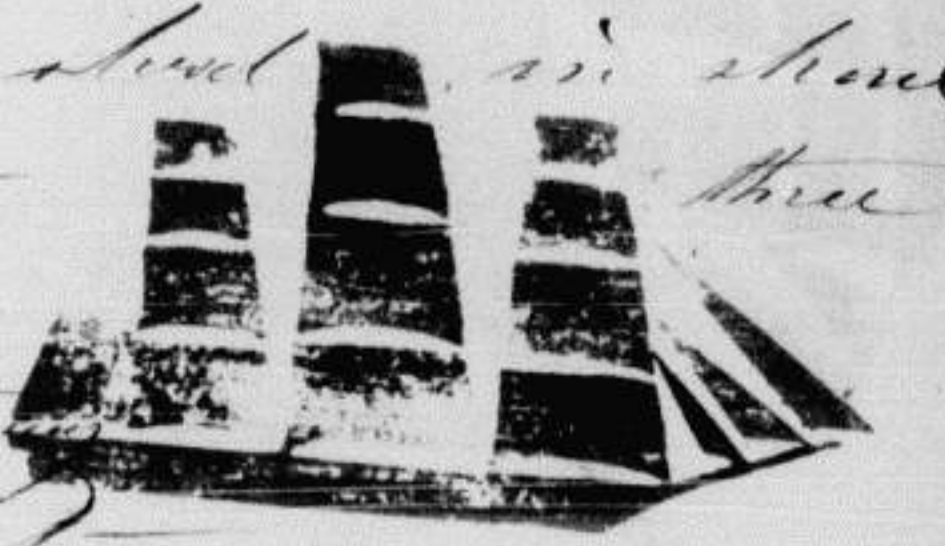
Commenced with fine breezes from south west and good weather no one to mast head steered to the southward and eastward at sundown took in sail heading east south east saw Terceira some fifteen miles off the weather bore had fresh breezes thru the night at daylight made sail and stood along the watch employed taring down and so forth saw a sail to the southward and eastward off So ends Cruising off Terceira

Remarks on board Tuesday May the 14th 1861

Commenced with fresh breezes from the southward and fair weather the watch employed in ordinary ships duty at sundown took in sail heading to the southward and eastward saw a sail steering to the northward at one o'clock A.M. one round and about in shore at daylight made sail saw three Whaler to the windward and one Merchant Ship steered to the northward latter part strong breezes So ends Cruising



Remarks on board Wednesday May the 15th 1861

Commenced with strong breezes from the southward and good weather saw a sail steering to the northward at four o'clock P.M. heard all three boats for Blackpile the barbed boat got part but drove again at sundown came on board and took in sail and headed off thru the night at daylight one round and stood in shore saw porpoise latter part strong breezes saw the land ahead one round and steered off shore commenced running off Terceira
