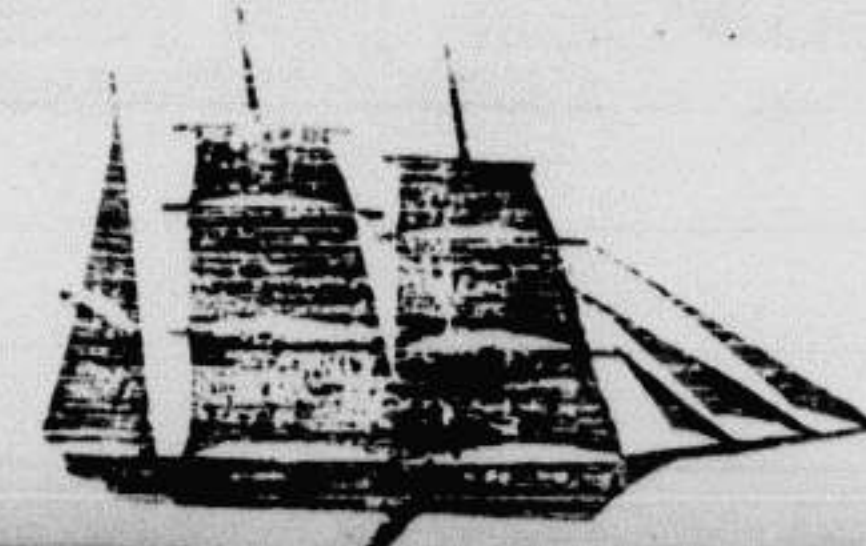
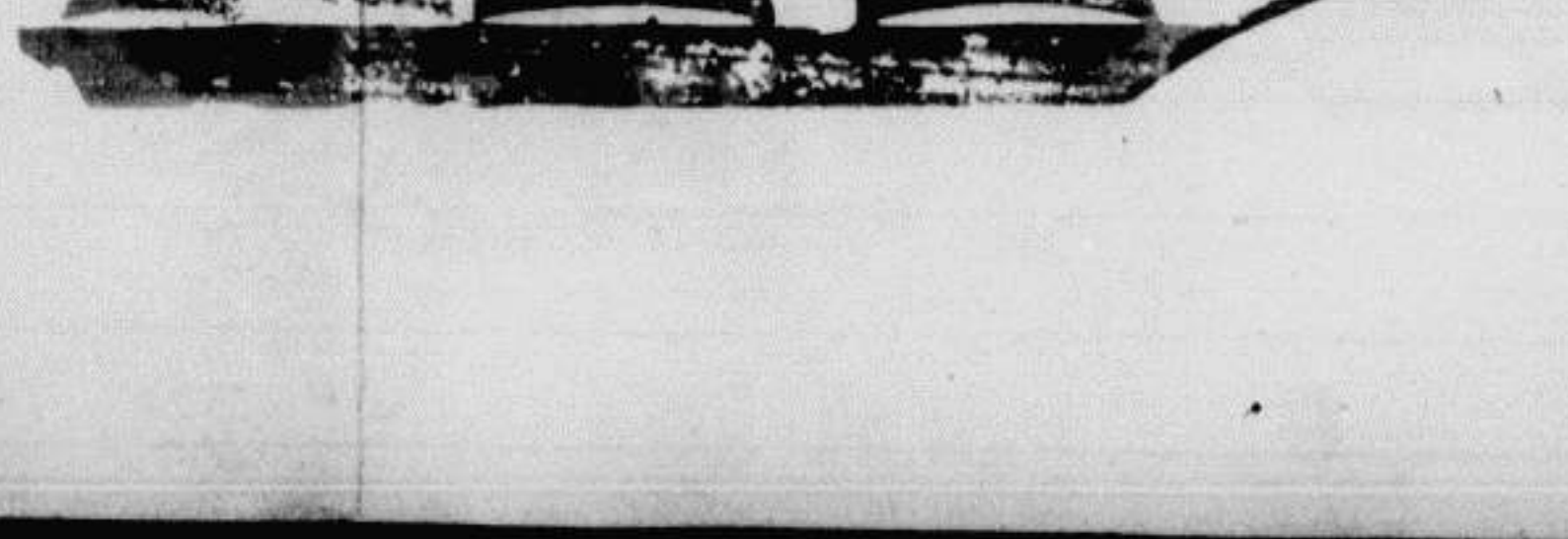
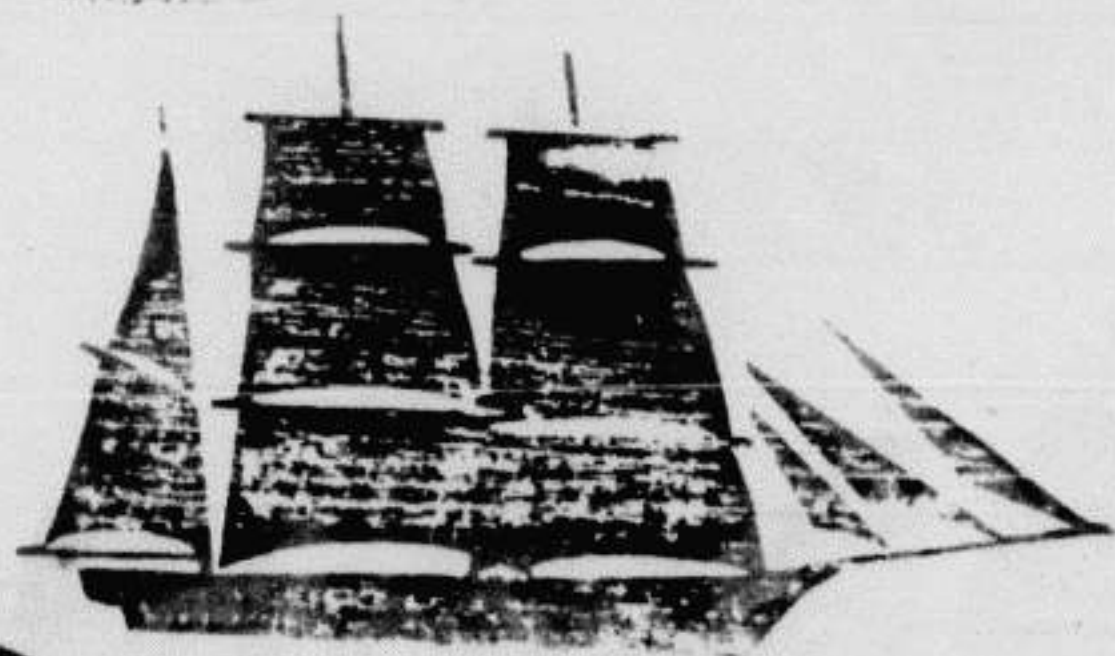
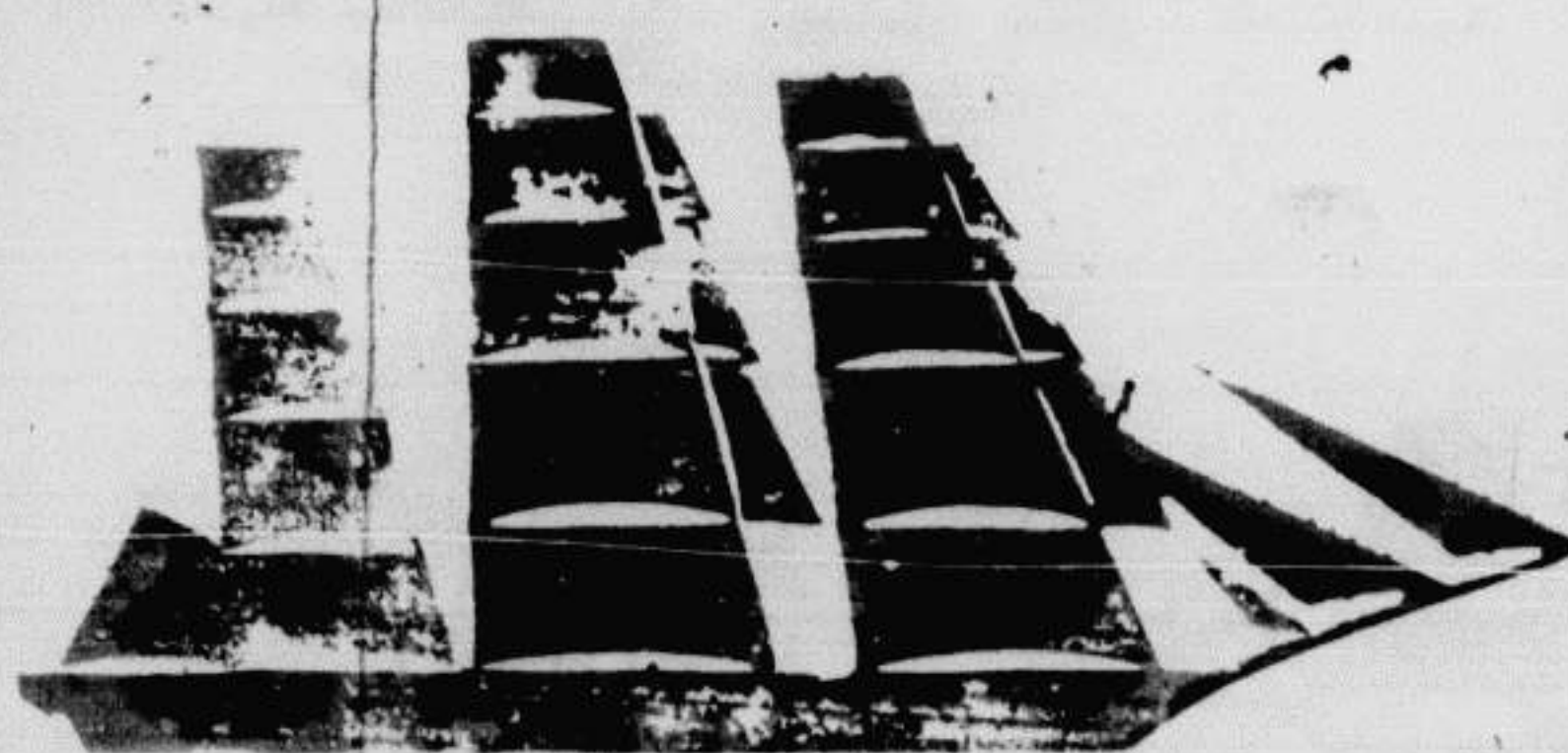
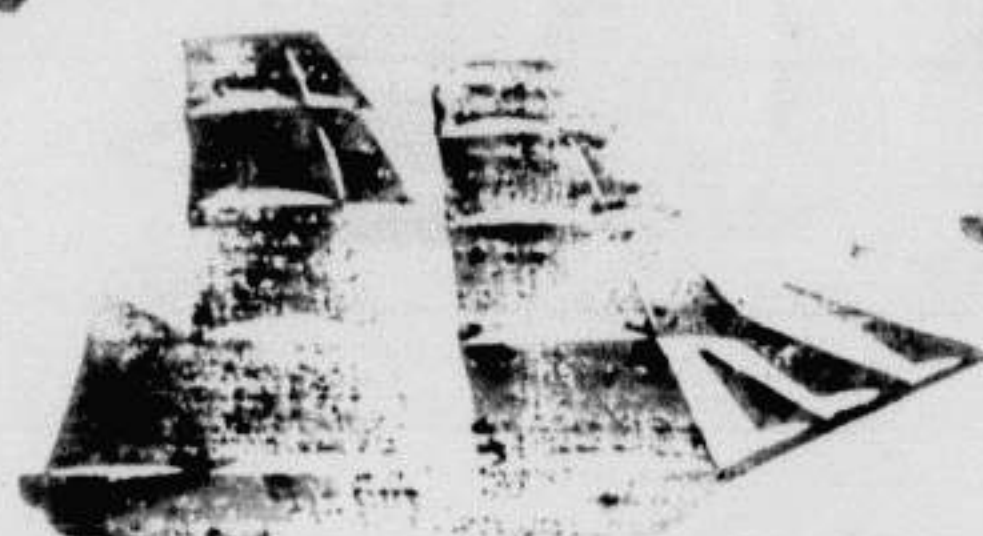
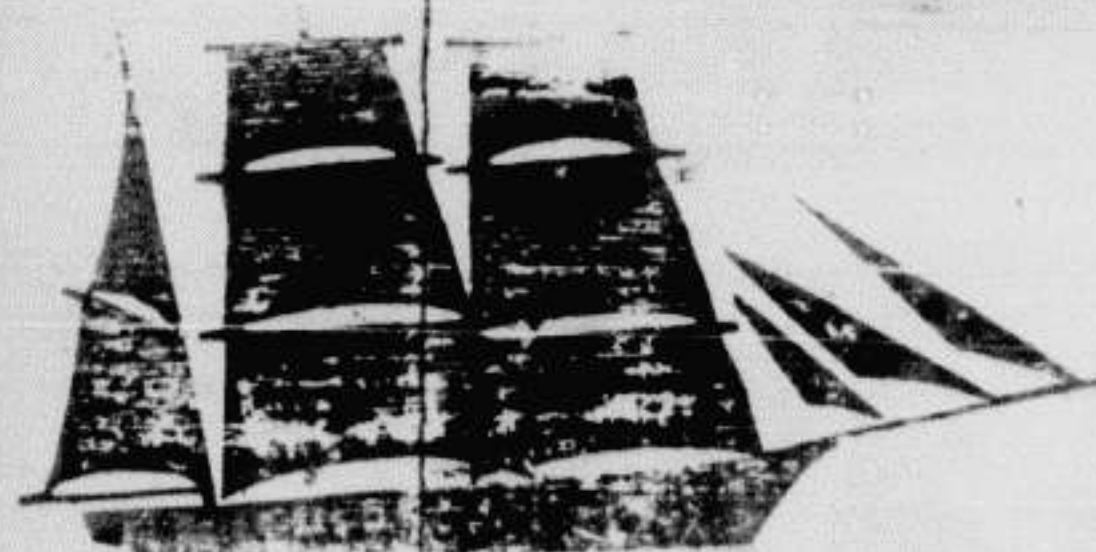
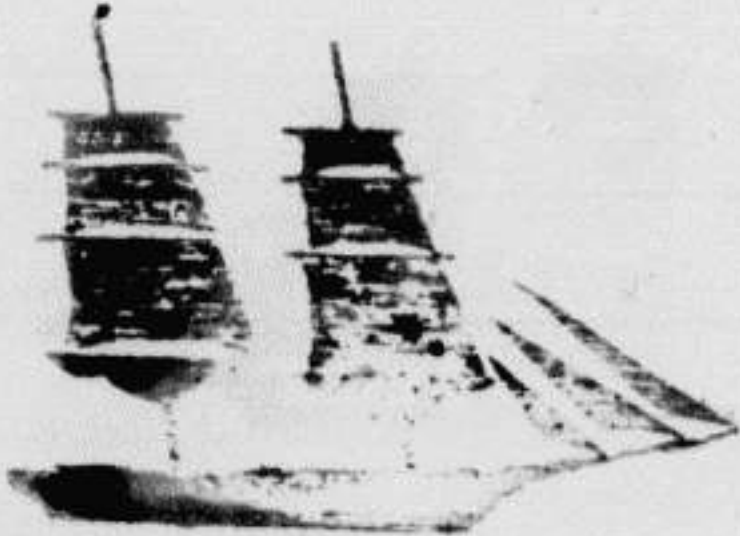
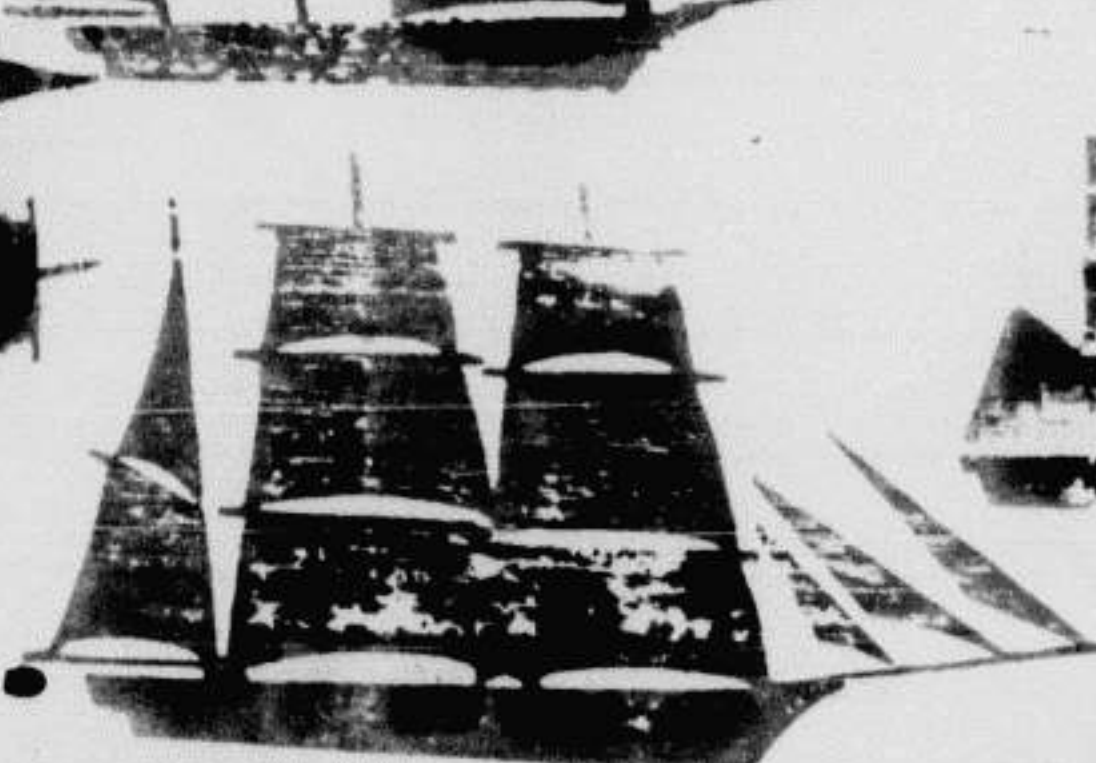
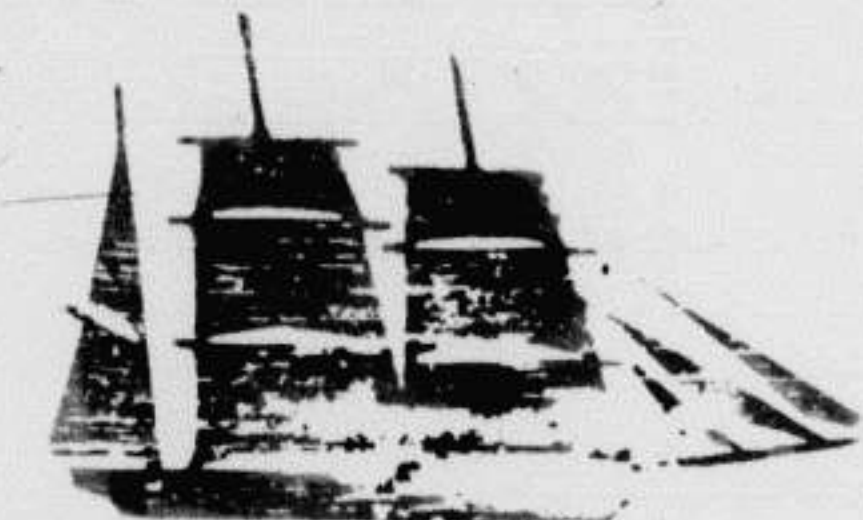
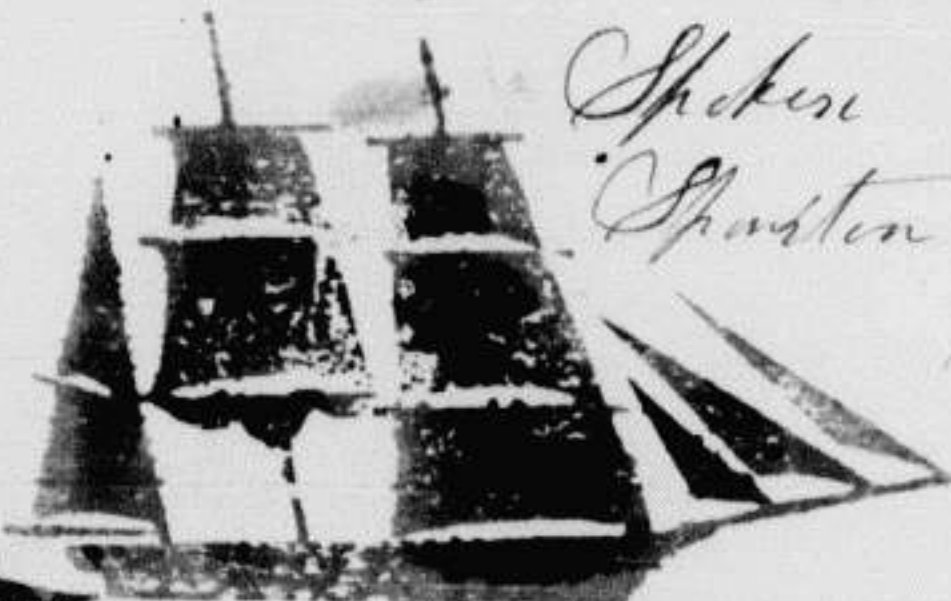
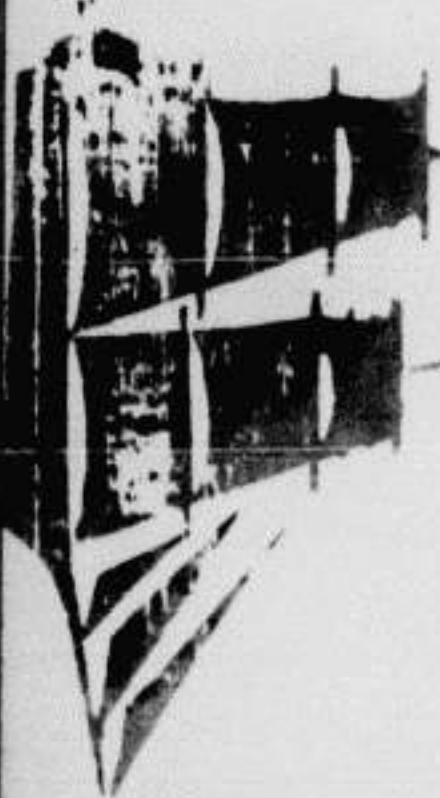
Remarks on board Tuesday June the 4th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from south east and good within the watch employed busy down the rigging saw porpoises and fishbacks at sundown took in sail had fine breeze then the night at daylight made sail and broke out for water and ahead saw a number of sails steering different courses both part fine breeze S. S. Lines steering north west latitude 32° 15' N longitude 84° 00' W

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Remarks on board Wednesday June the 5th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from the southwest and good within at one o'clock P. M. spoke the Bangor Spouter of Providence bound twenty days out then left to the wind and heard a boat and went along side of her to get some papers at two o'clock before the wind again saw several other sails steering to the southwest at sundown took in sail had fine breeze then the night at daylight made sail saw Steamships both part fresh breeze S. S. Lines steering west west latitude 32° 51' N longitude 84° 25' W

Remarks on board Thursday June the 6th 1861

Commenced with fresh breeze from south west and good within the watch employed in mending while duty saw four sails steering to the eastward at sundown took in sail and left to the wind heading west north west had fresh breeze then the night at daylight made sail and to the westward saw a number of sails both part strong breeze S. S. Lines heading to the westward latitude 32° 55' N longitude 84° 01' W
