

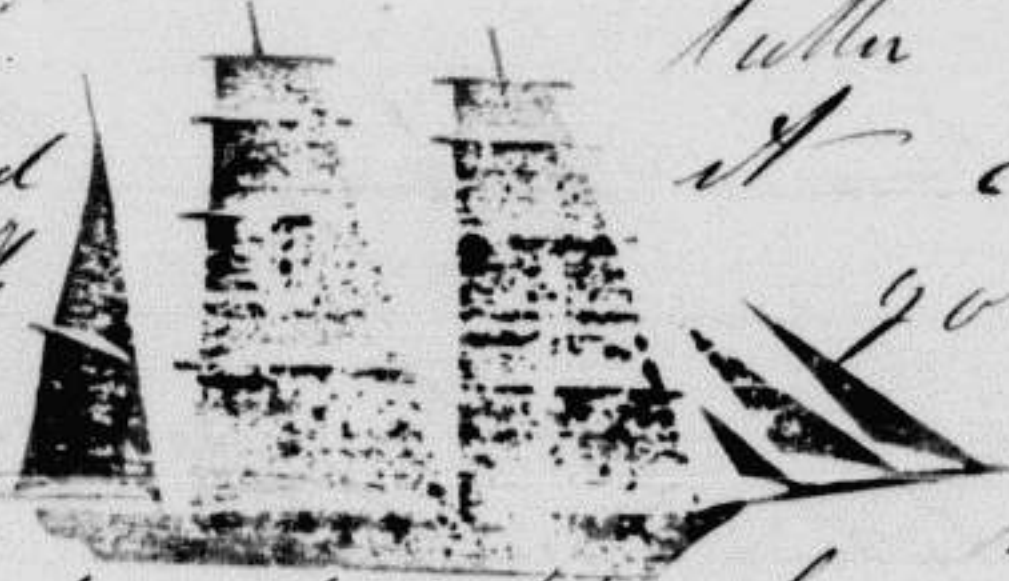
## Brig State Corp

Remarks on board Saturday June the 15th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from north west and good weather the watch employed in ordinary ship's duties saw humpbacks at sundown took in sail and backed ship to the northward had light breeze the fore part of the night at one A.M. backed ship to the westward at daylight made sail and stood on to the westward took out for water and other stores latter part light breeze heading west by north nothing in sight. Sooner latitude  $32^{\circ} 50'$  longitude  $35^{\circ} 40' W$

Remarks on board Sunday June the 16th 1861

Commenced with light breeze from the northward good weather the watch employed in ordinary ship's duties saw a sail steering south west at sundown took in sail heading west by the wind latter part of the night had it calm at seven o'clock A.M. got a light breeze from the westward heading to the northward latter part light breeze Sooner latitude



Remarks on board Monday June the 17th 1861

Commenced with light breeze from the westward and good weather saw humpbacks at sundown took in sail heading north by the wind had light breeze then the night at daylight

## Brig State Corp

Made sail and stood on to the northward and saw plenty of humpbacks and fine hawks saw a sail to the windward of us the watch employed heading west for shelter latter part fine breeze heading north north west Sooner latitude  $33^{\circ} 20'$  longitude  $37^{\circ} 20' W$

Remarks on board Tuesday June the 18th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from west south west and good weather saw humpbacks the watch employed in ordinary ship's duties at sundown took in sail heading north west saw a Brig steering to the eastward had light breeze then the night a day made sail and stood west by north saw a Brig steering to the westward latter part light breeze steering north west by north Sooner latitude  $32^{\circ} 25'$  longitude  $40^{\circ} 10' W$



Remarks on board Wednesday June the 19th 1861

Commenced with light breeze from the westward and good weather the watch employed in ordinary ship's duties saw a ship steering north east saw humpbacks at sundown took in sail had it calm then the night at day got a light breeze from the westward made sail and stood to the northward saw plenty of humpbacks latter part light breeze Sooner latitude  $32^{\circ} 10'$  longitude  $40^{\circ} 19' W$
