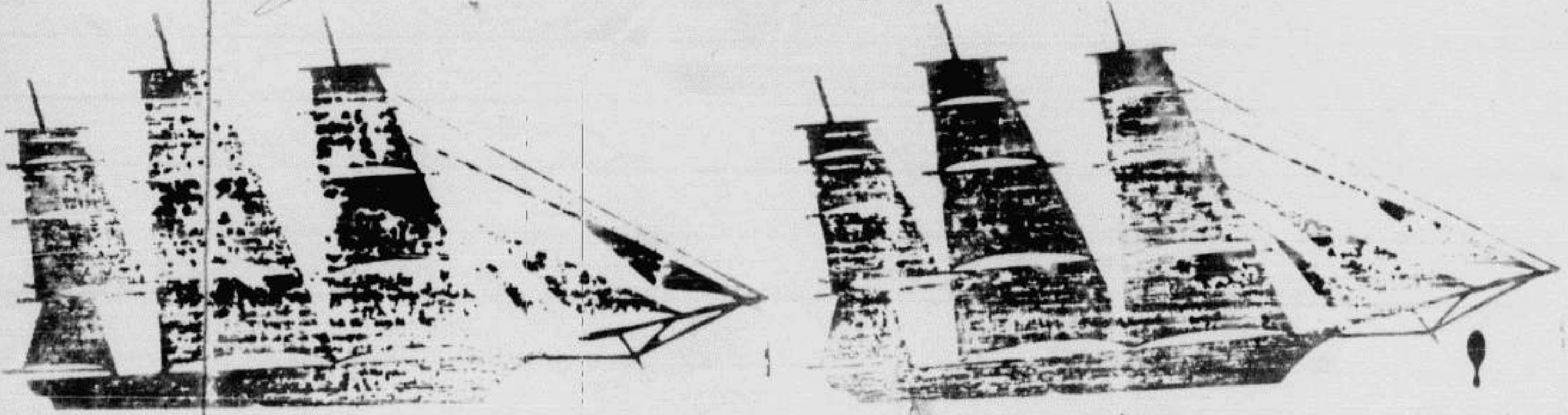
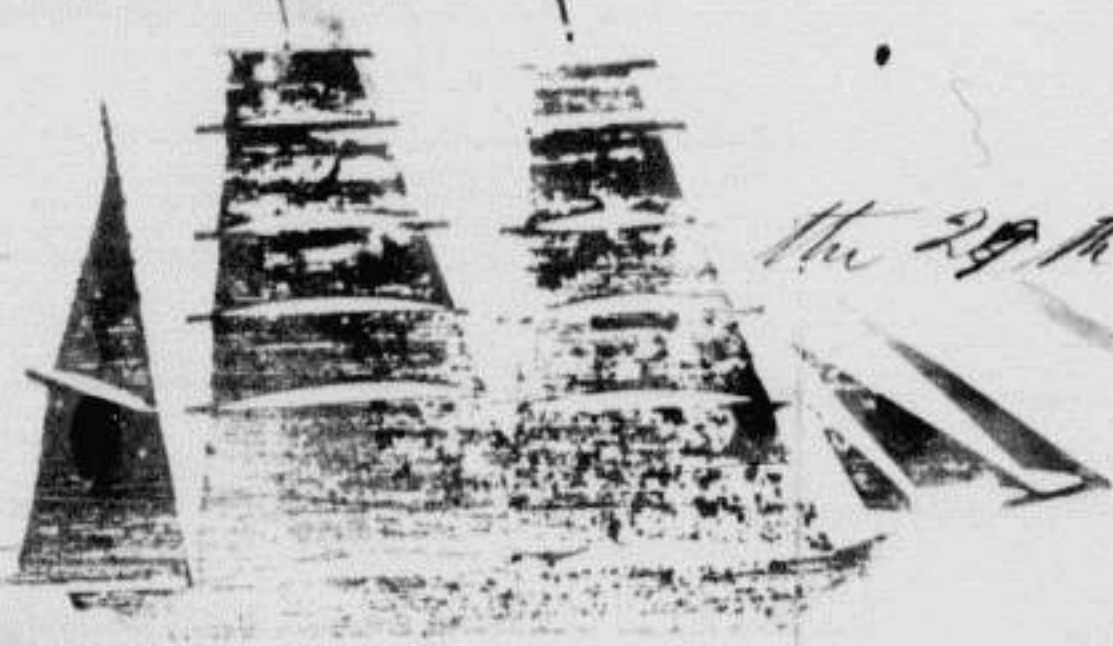


Brig *Heath* Day Cruising

 and got ready and commenced making out saw
 three sails starting to the eastward latter
 part light breeze S. end latitude 38° 44' N
 longitude 40° 55' W



Remarks on board Saturday June the 29th 1861

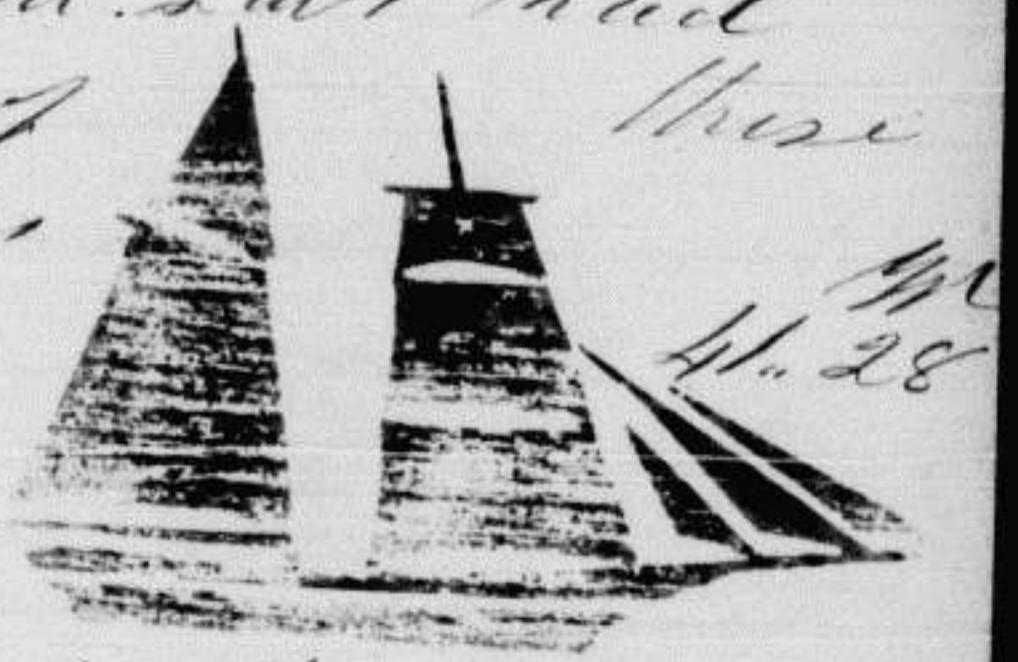
Commenced with light -
 breeze from the northward
 and good water the watch employed in making
 out saw fliers at three o'clock P.M. got
 down making out and stood off some more
 from the sail breeze at sundown took in
 sail had it calm threw the night at
 11 o'clock P.M. got a light breeze
 from the westward set all sail and
 stood to the southward and westward latter
 part light breeze S. end latitude
 38° 27' longitude 41° 00' W



Remarks on board Sunday June the 30th 1861

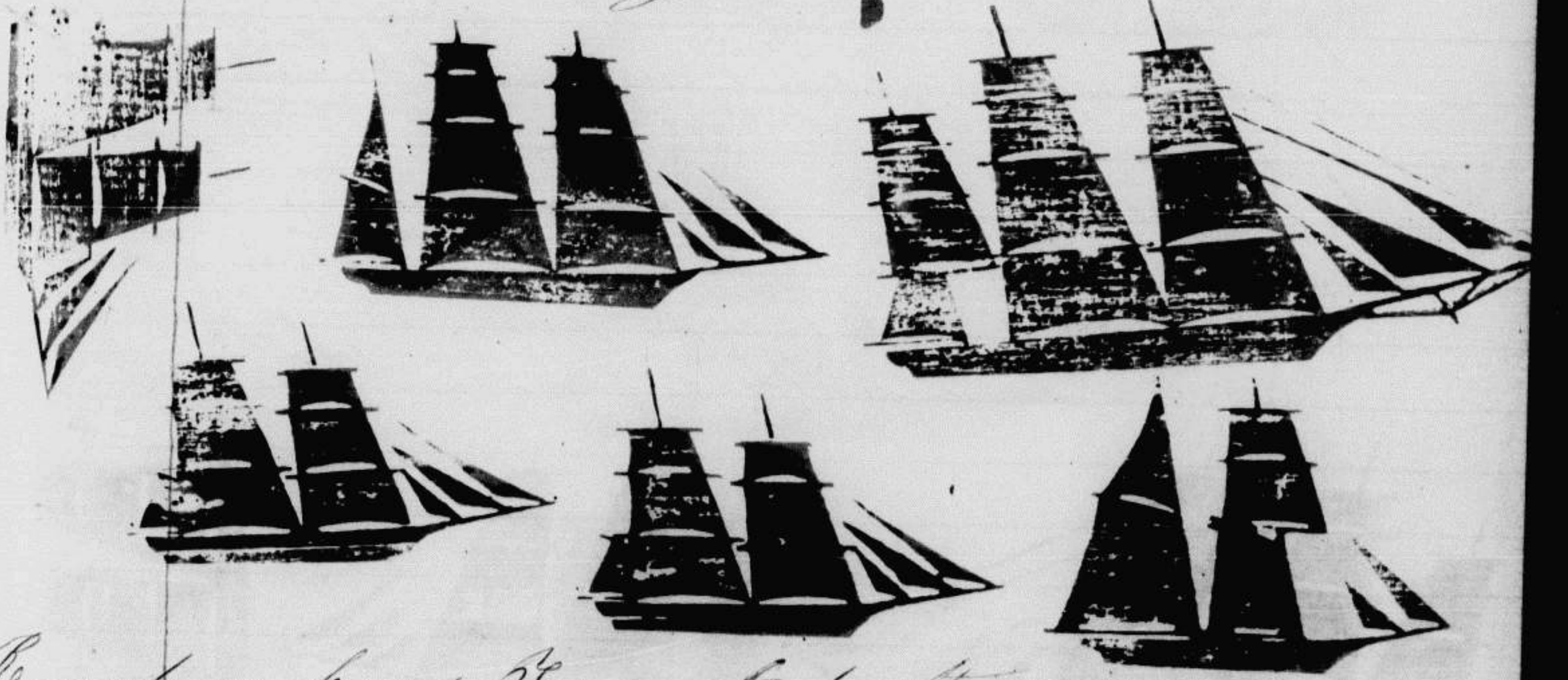
Commenced with light breeze from southward
 and westward saw grampies the watch
 employed in evening ship's clocks saw
 a ship's compass and found a boat and
 went to it caught a few fish and
 one sail to the southward and eastward

Brig *Heath* Day Cruising
 Off us at sundown took in sail had
 it calm the remainder of
 night few hours S. end
 latitude 38° 05' N longitude 41° 28' W



Remarks on board Monday July the 1st 1861

Commenced with light air from south
 west and good water heading to the
 southward under short sail had it calm
 threw the night at nine o'clock P.M.
 got a light breeze from the southward
 made sail and stood to the westward
 saw six sails starting to the eastward
 latter part light breeze S. end latitude
 37° 49' N longitude 41° 42' W



Remarks on board Tuesday July the 2nd 1861

Commenced with light breeze from south
 west and good water the watch employed
 in evening ship's clocks saw thousands of fish
 at six o'clock P.M. raised blackfish and
 heard the boats for three but could
 not get near enough to fasten upon
 them up and came on board and took
 in sail had it calm threw the night
