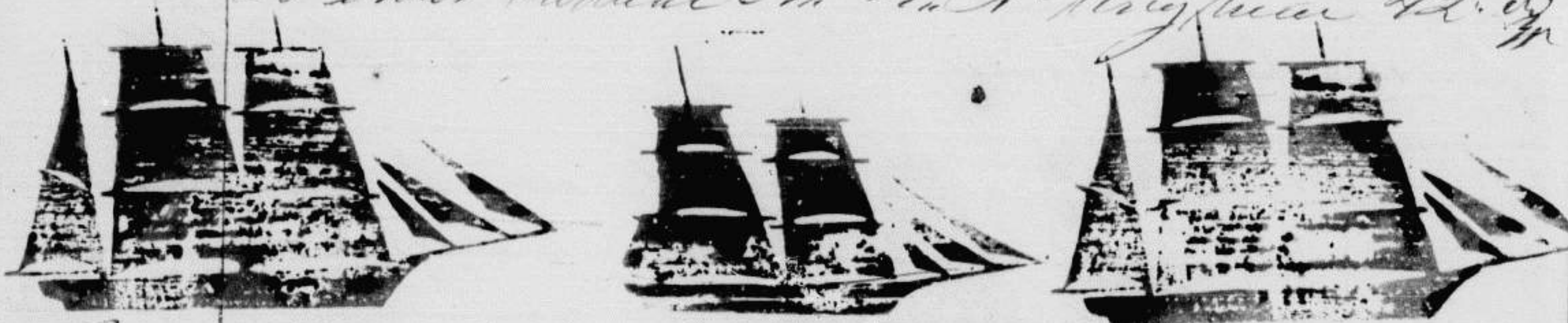


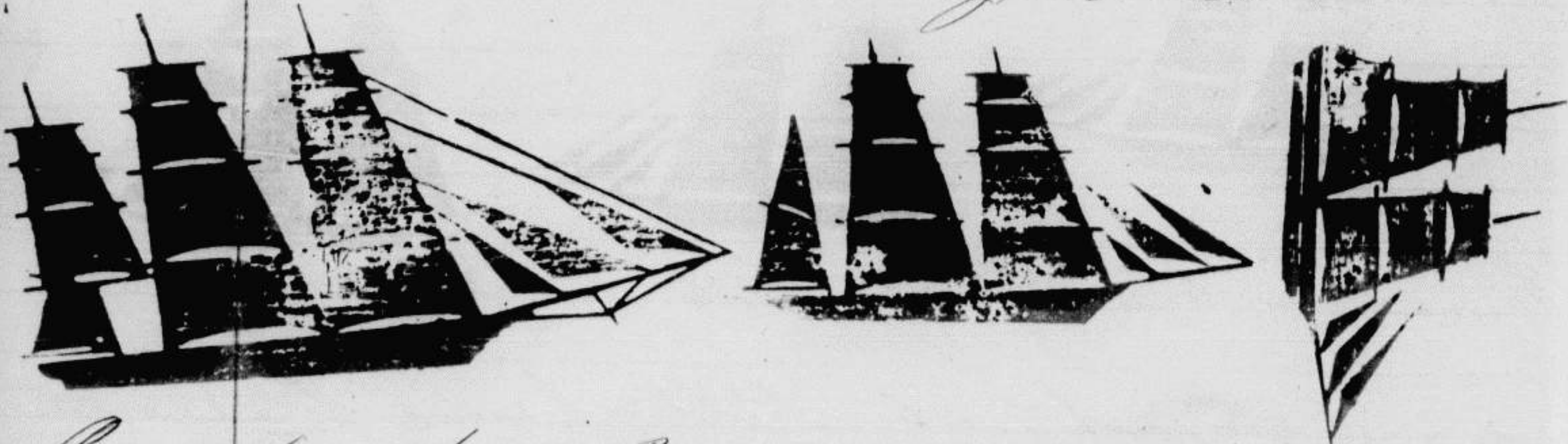
Brig Kate Gray Cruising

At daylight got a light breeze from the southward made sail and stood to the westward saw the sails steering to the southwest later put light air backed ship to the eastward So under latitude 38° 54' Longitude 42° 00' W



Remarks on board Wednesday July the 3rd 1861

Remained with light breeze from the southward and good weather the watch employed in coining tops sails at six o'clock P.M. found the boats for billocks but could not get past the harbor boat - caught a turtle at sundown came on board and took in sail had it calm through the night at daylight went to work getting out water (and cleaning and painting the iron work) latter part calm other sails in sight So under latitude 38° 54' Longitude 42° 00' W

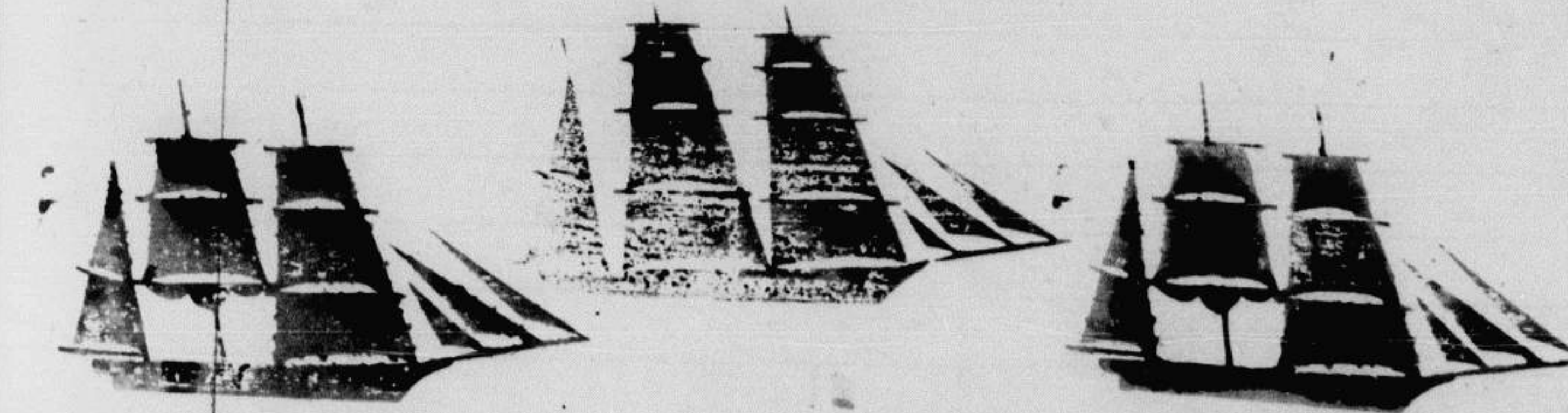
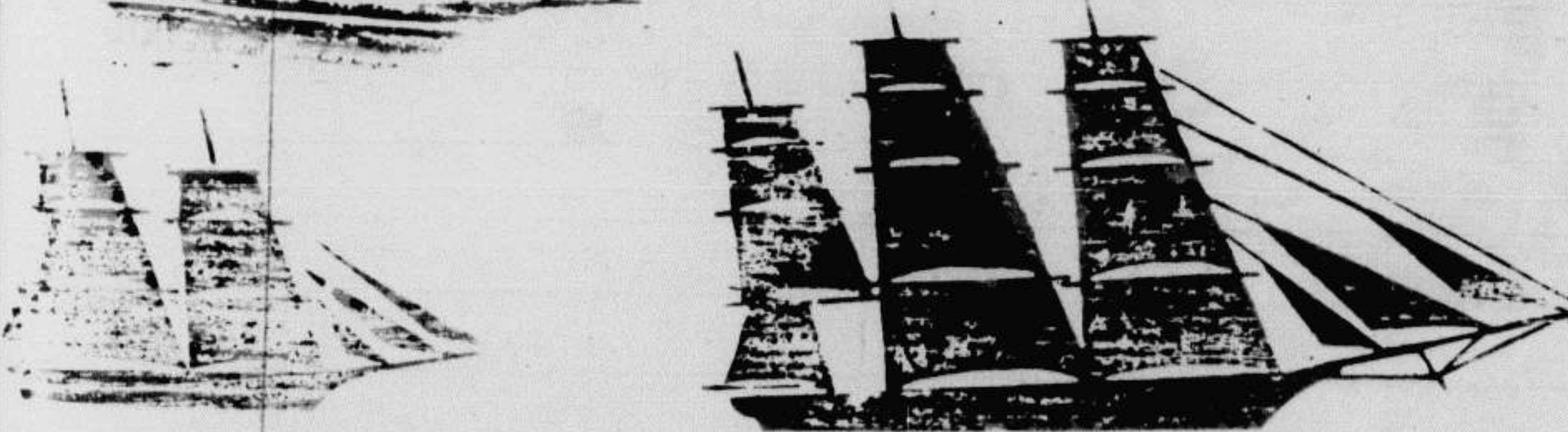
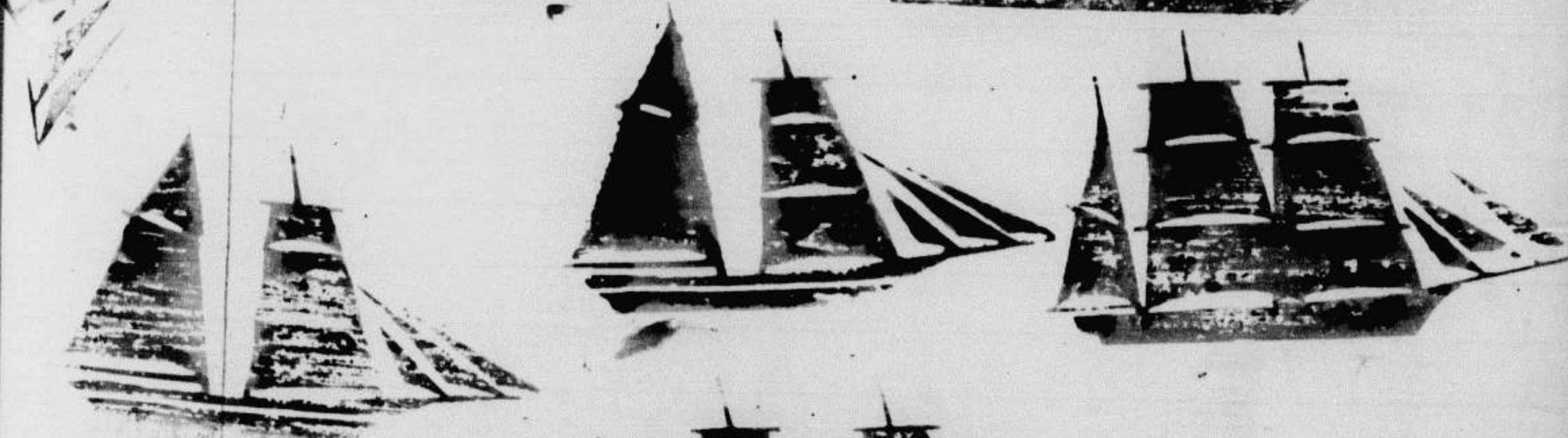
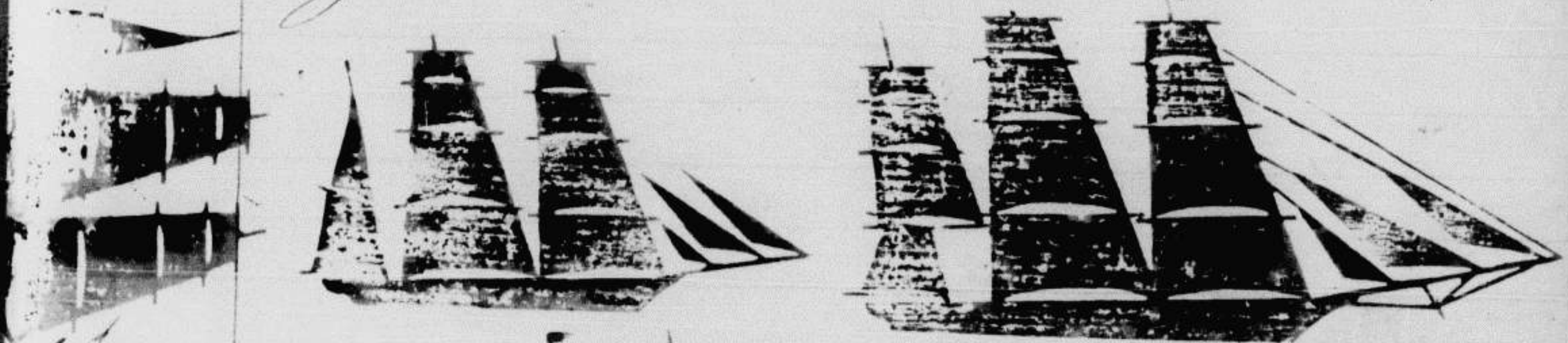


Remarks on board Thursday July the 4th 1861

Remained with good weather but calm the watch employed cleaning and painting the iron work at three o'clock P.M. got a light breeze from north west stand northward grasshoppers and pupae

Had light breeze through the night at daylight made sail and stood on to the southward saw Blackbird later put five braces set sail in sight So under latitude 38° 56' Longitude 41° 55' W
