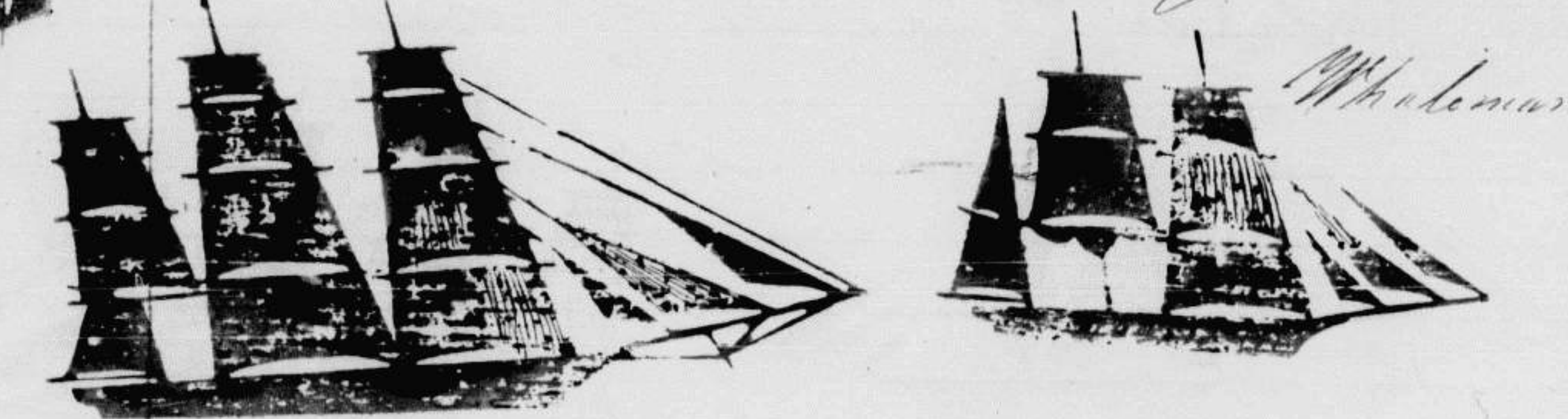
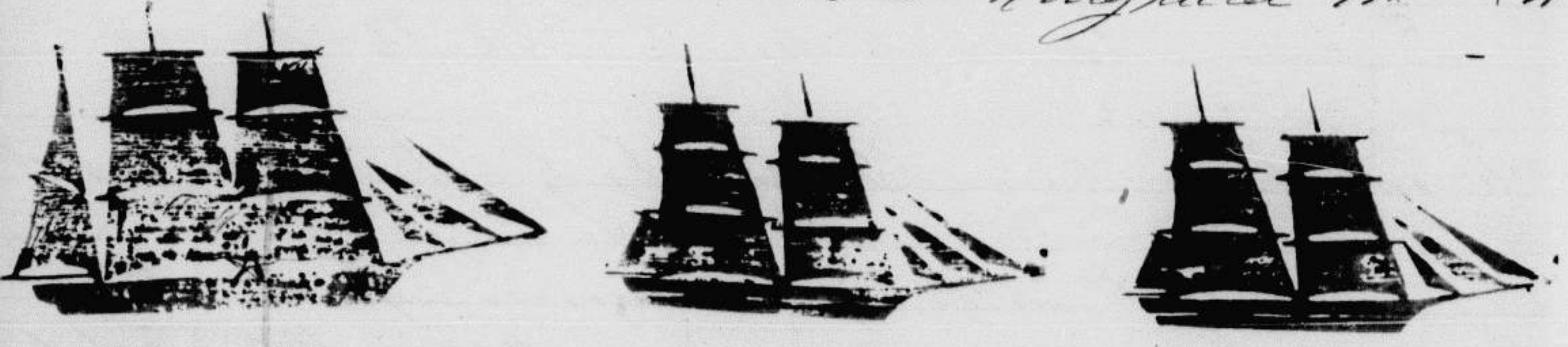


Brig Flute Cory Cruising

Remarks on Board Saturday July the 13th 1861

Commenced with fresh breeze from east
 South east and fair weather the watch
 employed making out for business saw
 a ship steering to the eastward
 Under all sail at sundown took in
 Sail heading south by west had
 strong breeze then the night at seven
 o'clock the were rounded to the eastward
 blowing strong and squally with a
 Brig and Barque steering to the eastward
 latter part raged and squally with a
 So ends Latitude 35^o 46' Longitude 41^o 52'



Remarks on board Sunday July the 14th 1861

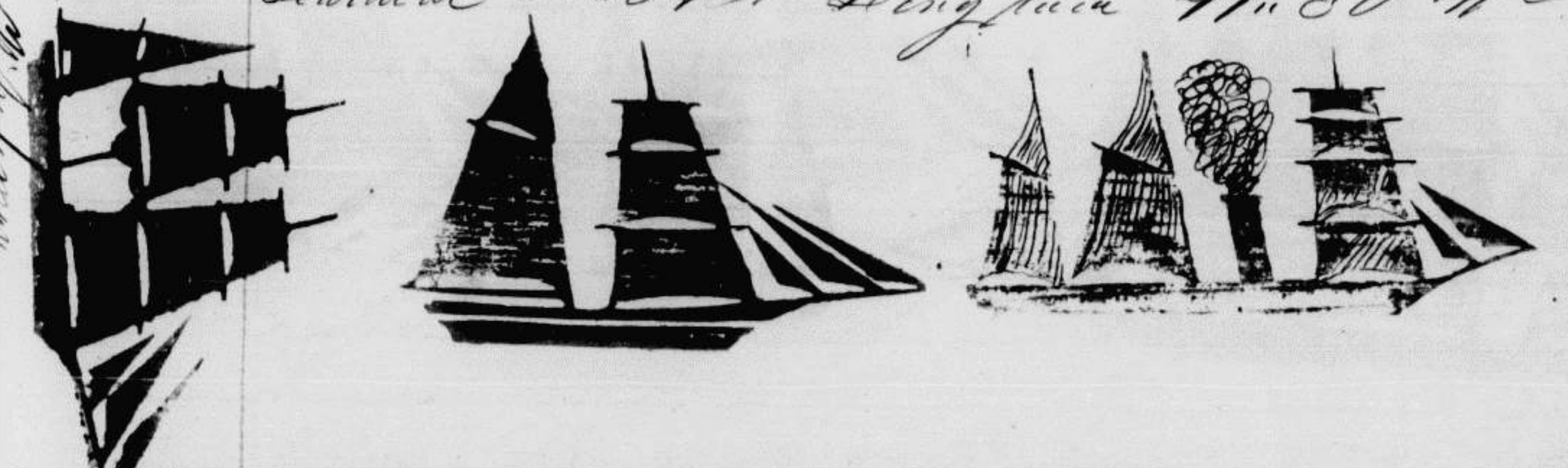
Commenced with strong breeze from south

 had strong breeze and squally with a
 Then the night at seven o'clock the
 were rounded to the southward and westward

 to the eastward again So ends Latitude
 35^o 40' Longitude 41^o 30'

Remarks on board Monday July the 15th 1861

Commenced with moderate gales from
 south south west and raged with a
 heading to the eastward at sundown
 had a more moderate at twelve o'clock
 the were ship to the south west at day
 light made sail had good weather got
 steady and broke out for water and business
 saw ketches latter part five breezes saw a
 Steam ship steering to the eastward and
 a brig steering to the eastward So ends
 Latitude 35^o 34' Longitude 41^o 30'



Remarks on board Tuesday July the 16th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from south south
 East and good weather the watch employed
 In evening ship's duty at sundown took
 in sail saw a Whaling Bark to windward
 had light breeze then the night
