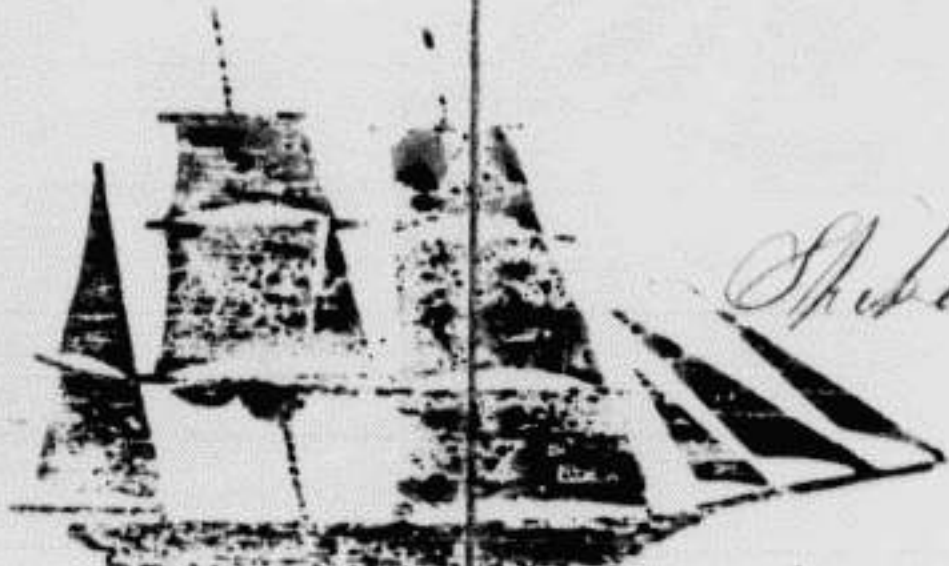


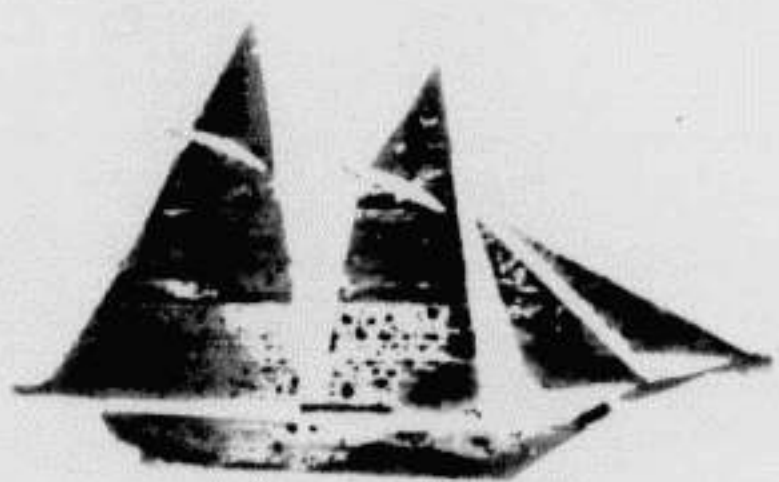
Brig Kate Cory Cruising

Remarks on board Wednesday August the 21st 1861

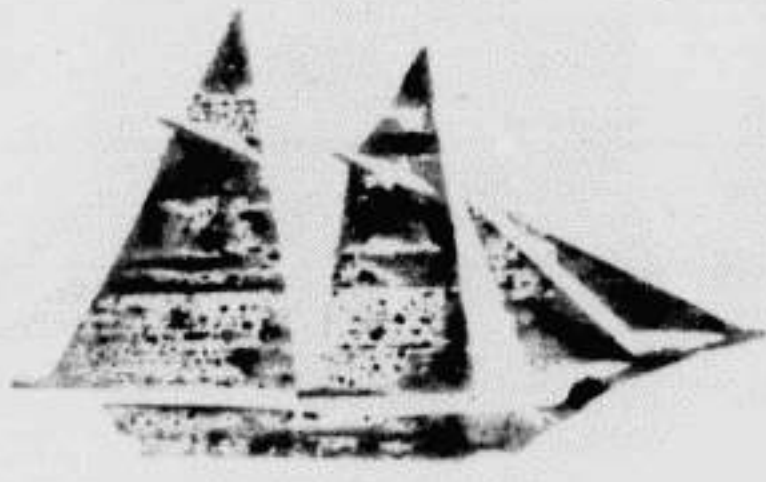
Commenced with fine breeze from the westward and good weather the watch employed setting up the fore and aft stays at sundown took in sail the schooner Palmira spoke as steamed north through the night at daylight made sail and stood on a new Black Sea latter part increased in strong south in the morning and recd the report saw two Schooners to the windward W. So ends Latitude 28° 30' N Longitude 81° 16'

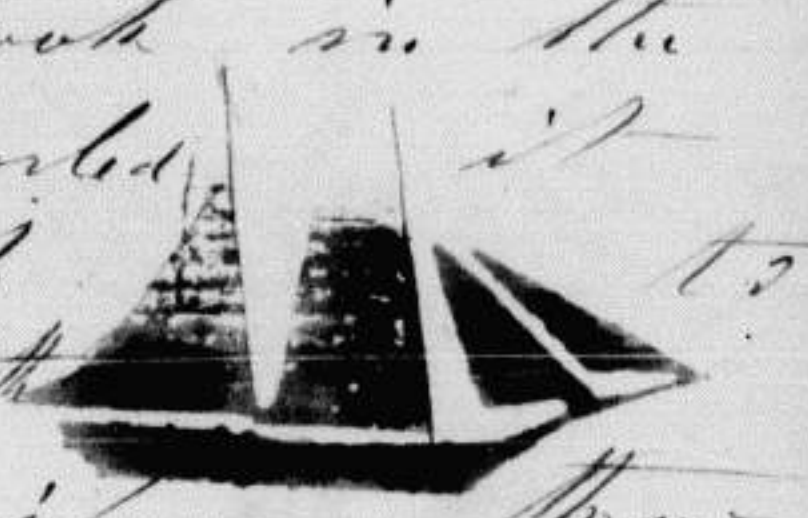
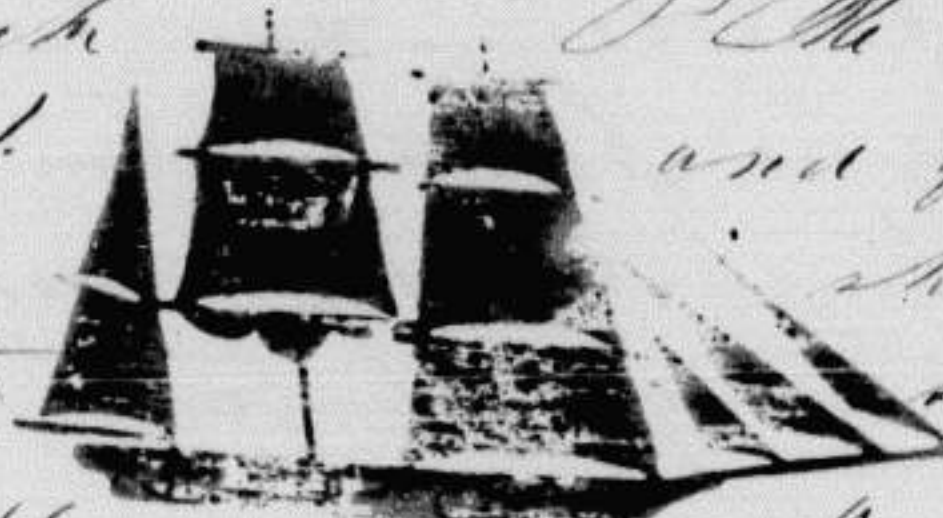
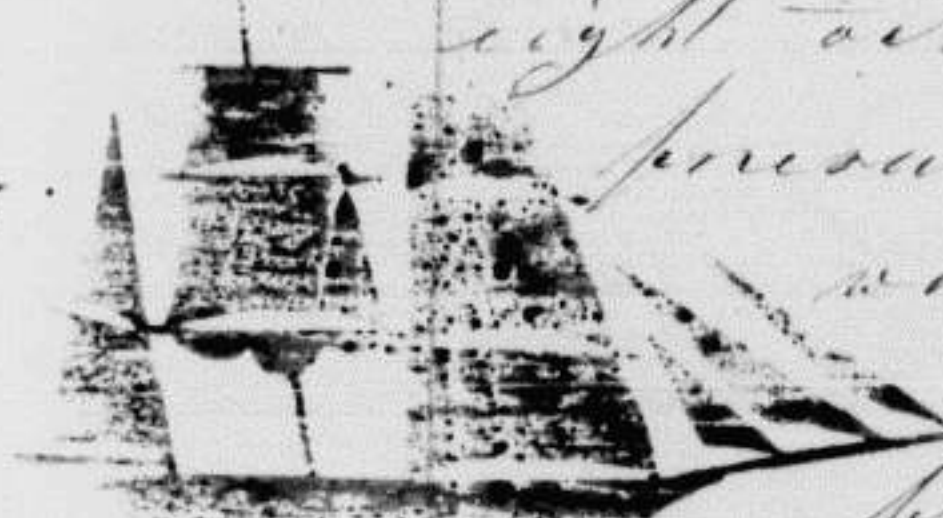
Remarks on board Thursday August the 22nd 1861

Commenced with strong breeze from west and weather was rough within the watch employed in various ships sails at sundown took in sail the schooner Ellen of Edingburgh Captain Churchman came along side after letting her heading north west by the wind latter part of the night blew on to a moderate gail took in the foremast and foretopmast and fore ship to the windward saw a bark to the leeward lying to under a reef main topmast saw a schooner latter part blowing strong and thick and rainy weather stood no mast heads So ends no latitude and no path

Remarks on board Friday August the 23rd 1861

Commenced with a moderate gail from south west and thick and rainy weather at two o'clock D.M. set the foremast and arranged the mast heads at sundown one ship headed west north west at eight o'clock D.M. took in the foremast and furled it were the ship with them the night at eight o'clock D.M. one ship again headed west south west had it rainy the remainder of these twenty four hours So ends Latitude 28° 42' N Longitude 81° 07' W



Remarks on board Saturday August the 24th 1861

Commenced with a moderate gail from south west and rough and squally weather nothing going on with sunbaking saw a large American ship steaming to the eastward saw a whaling bark to the windward at five o'clock were ship to the southward and eastward had strong breeze through the night and rainy weather latter part strong breeze and squally weather at ten minutes before twelve the sun came out got the latitude So ends Latitude 29° 45' N Longitude 81° 50' W
