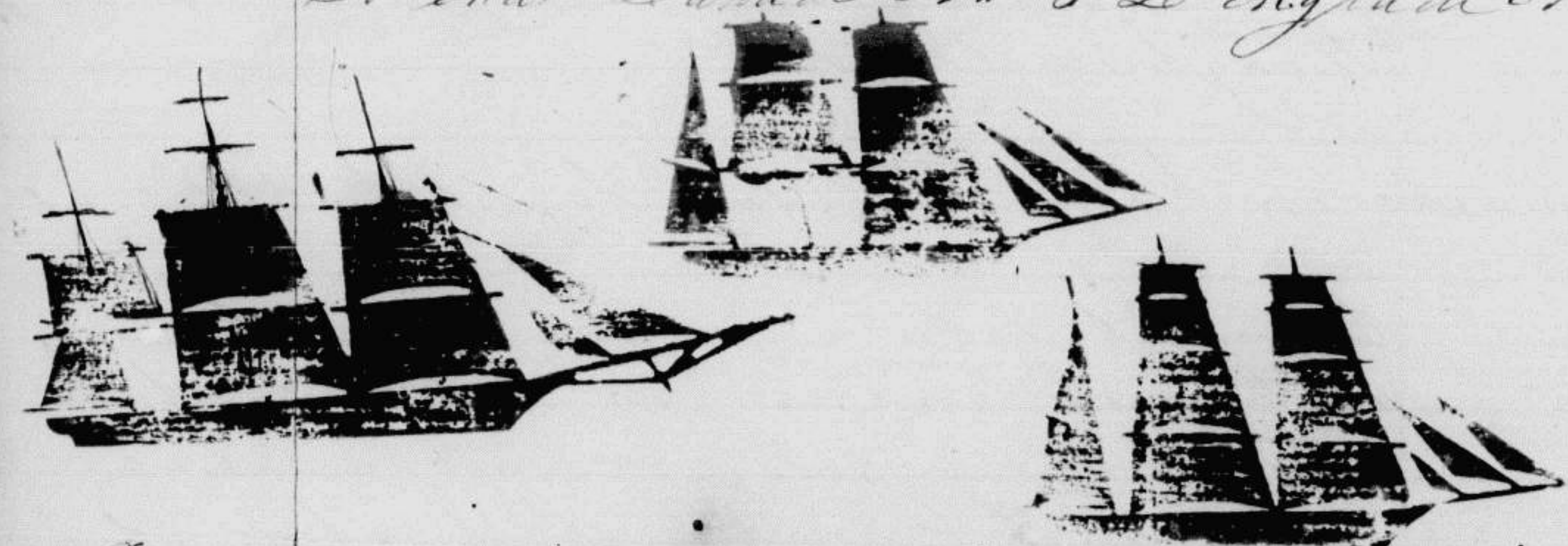
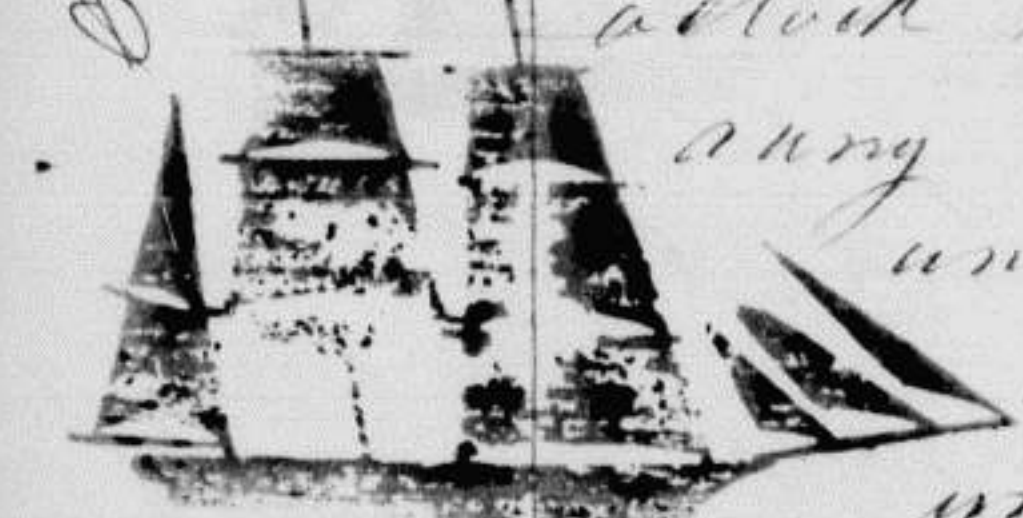


Brig Kate Carey Cruising

Remarks on board Sunday August the 25th 1861

Commenced with strong breezes from the southward and squally weather at 10 o'clock. At 11 o'clock the foremast and foretopmast at sundown spoke the Barque Excelsior of Sag Harbor 22 days out with sixty five barrels of wheat along side and got some papers taken in the fore topmast heading west by south at 1 o'clock were still to the eastward had it away at daylight ahead of were round and made sail saw the Bark Excelsior to the windward and a ship name unknown latter part fine breezes off. So ends Latitude 39° 58' Longitude 87° 52'

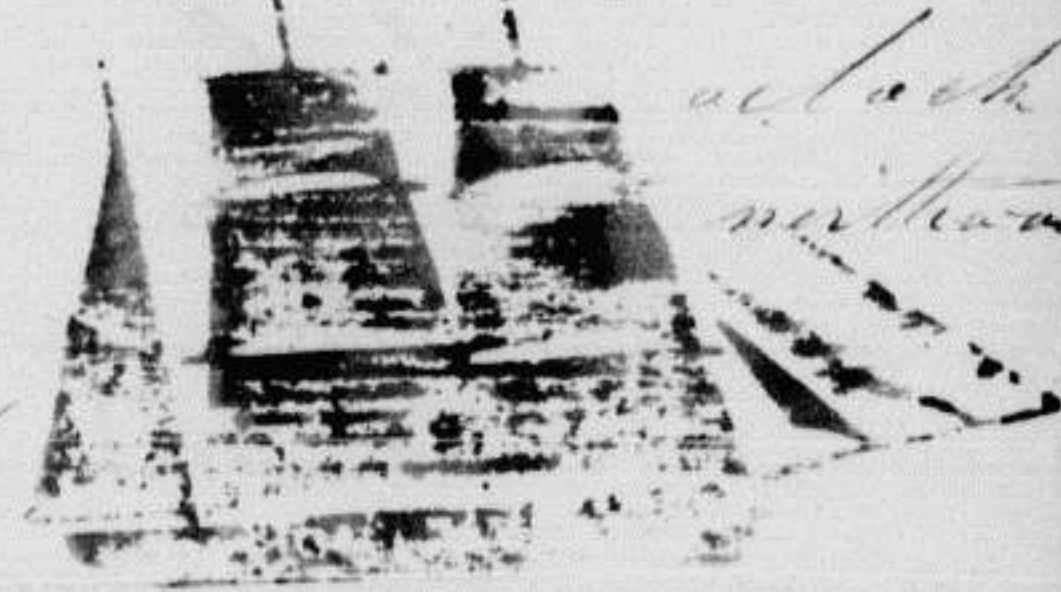
Remarks on board Monday August the 26th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from the south and fair weather heading to the eastward saw three sails at sundown took in sail had light breezes thru the night at daylight set all sail and stood to the southward the watch employed breaking in for water and provisions saw lots of Grampus saw a sail to the northward of us latter part light breezes nothing in sight So ends this day Latitude 39° 57' N Longitude 88° 08' W

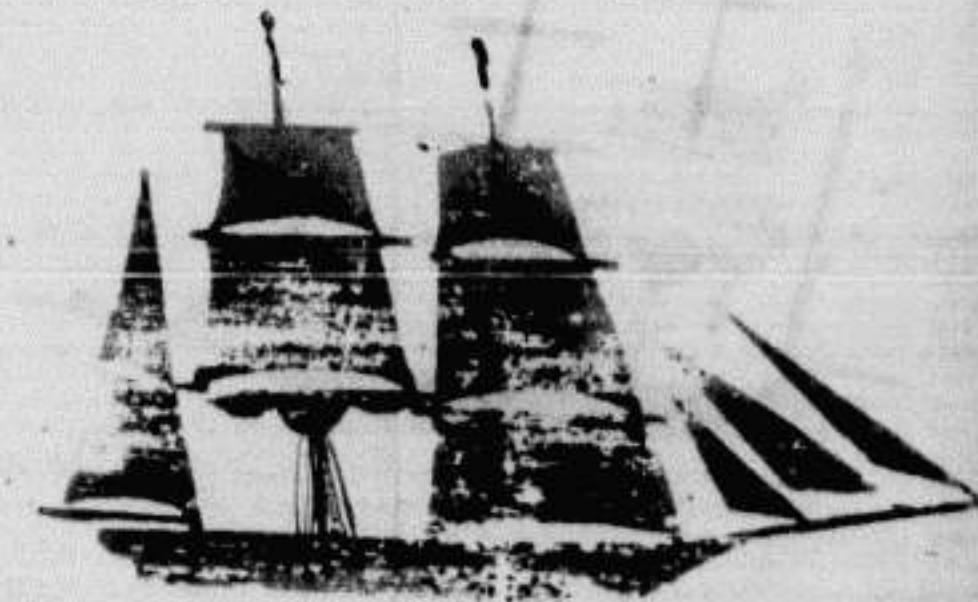
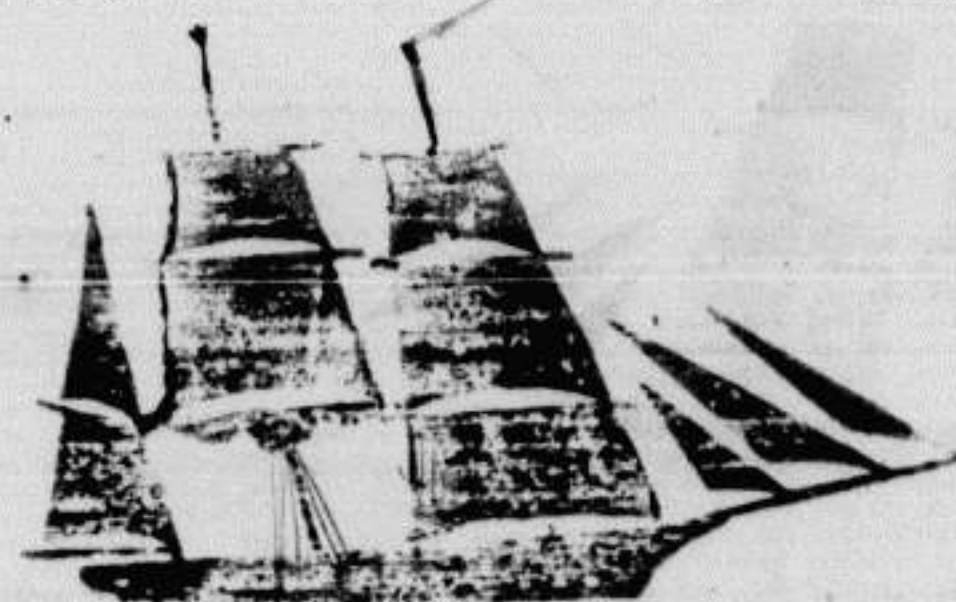

Remarks on board Tuesday August the 27th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from the westward and good weather the watch employed making new jib penants saw plenty of Grampus and Porpoise but no whales at sundown took in sail at twelve. At 1 o'clock were round to the northward at daylight set the jib and mainsail had fresh breezes were round to the southward saw a Brig steering to the eastward latter part thick drizzly weather So ends no Latitude and no Longitude

Remarks on board Wednesday August the 28th 1861

Commenced with strong breezes from the westward and thick drizzly weather at 1 o'clock set all sail at three o'clock the wind shifted round north east and lighted up some sail down the middle of stay and repaired it and got it aloft again at sundown took in sail further the foretopmast heading off south by the wind latter part of the night. At 1 o'clock many calm had a heavy swell running from north east latter part calm So ends Latitude 39° 30' N Longitude 88° 30' W
