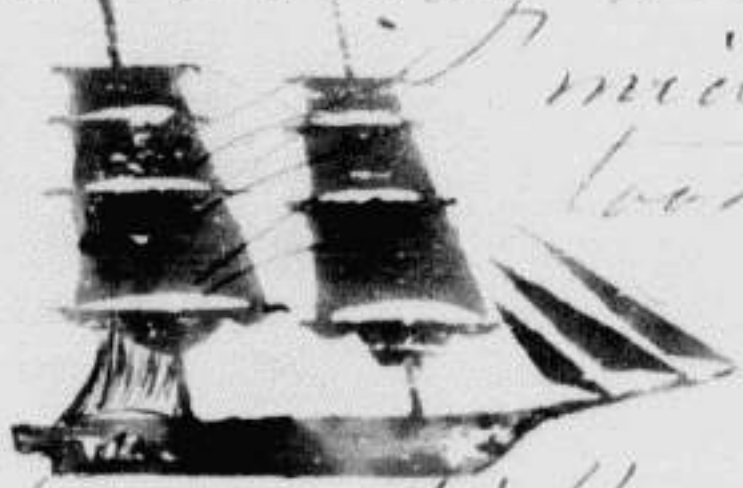


Brig Kate Cory Cruising

At sundown left to the wind to the westward
look in the forenoon blowing strong latter part
of the night had it more moderate at daylight and the
forenoon had a heavy south running breeze from the
northward latter part light breeze on sail on sight
So ends Lat 20° 20' N Long 21° 21' W

Remarks on board Thursday October the 3rd 1861

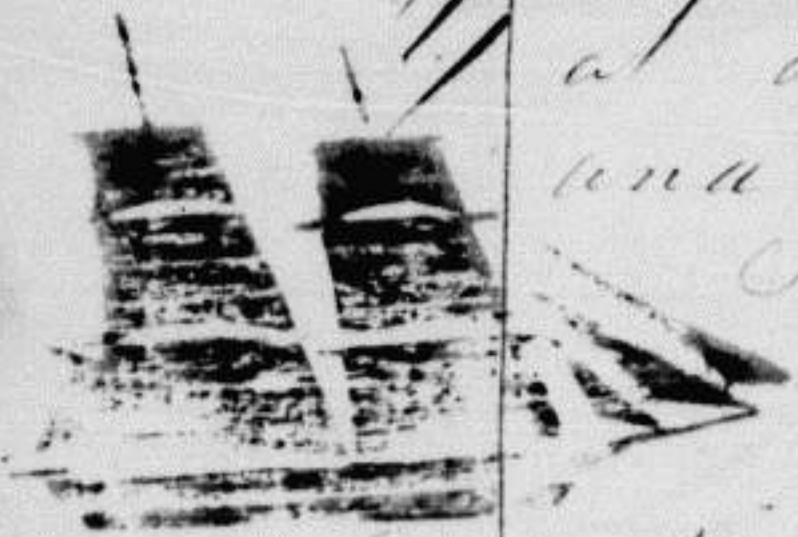
Commenced with light breezes from the north
and a heavy sea going the water employed
in ordinary ship's duties set the jib and



middle stay sail at sundown
look in sail had it a little
more moderate making to the westward
had light air then the night
at daylight clear away calm sea still
latter part calm on sail on sight So ends
Lat 21° 22' N Long 21° 21' W

Remarks on board Friday October the 4th 1861

Commenced with good water but calm the water employed
in ordinary ship's duties at three o'clock P.M.
got a light breeze from the northward and
eastward heading to the northward and
westward had light breezes then the night
at daylight made sail broke out for water
and small stores latter part light breeze
So ends Lat 21° 30' N Long 21° 41' W



Remarks on board Saturday October the 5th 1861

Commenced with light breezes from north east
and good water the water employed getting
new eating biscuits at sundown look
sail heading north by the wind had light
breezes then the night at daylight set full
sail and stood on to the northward latter part
fine breezes nothing in sight So ends Lat 22° 03' N Long 21° 52' W

Remarks on board Sunday October the 6th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from north with
east and good water nothing going on
with remarking at four o'clock P.M. took
ship to the eastward at sundown took in sail
heading east by the wind had fine breezes
then the night heading south east latter part
good water So ends Lat 22° 03' N Long 21° 52' W

Remarks on board Monday October the 7th 1861.

Commenced with fine breezes from the eastward
and good water heading to the southward
and eastward had light air then the
night at daylight made sail and
steered south south east saw to sails the
water employed in ordinary ship's duties
latter part calm nothing in sight So
ends Lat 22° 40' N Longitude 21° 52' W

Remarks on board Tuesday October the 8th 1861

Commenced with good water but calm
turned off the forenoon and pointed
it at sundown look
in sail still
in ordinary ship's duties latter part
of the night got a light
breeze at daylight set all sail and
steered south south east saw a sail
standing to the northward latter part
fine breezes So ends Lat 23° 21' N
Long 21° 52' W
