

187. Brig Kate Carey off Canary Islands

Latter part of the night breasted up strong at eight o'clock. At 10 left off south west latter part strong breeze. So ends off Canary Islands

Remarks on board Wednesday October the 16th 1861

Commenced with strong breeze from the northward and raged within the watch employed in ordinary ship's duty steering south west at sundown saw the land off the starboard quarter and strong breeze threw the night at daylight broke out for water latter part fresh breeze steering south west. So ends. Lat 25th 20' N Long 15th 44' W

Remarks on board Thursday October the 17th 1861

Commenced with fresh breeze from north east and fair within saw a few small blackfish did not leave the watch employed in ordinary ship's duty at sundown set the fore topgallant had fine breeze threw the night at daylight cleared down the topgallant saw a grampus latter part fine breeze. So ends steering south west. Lat 24th 15' N Long 19th 11' W

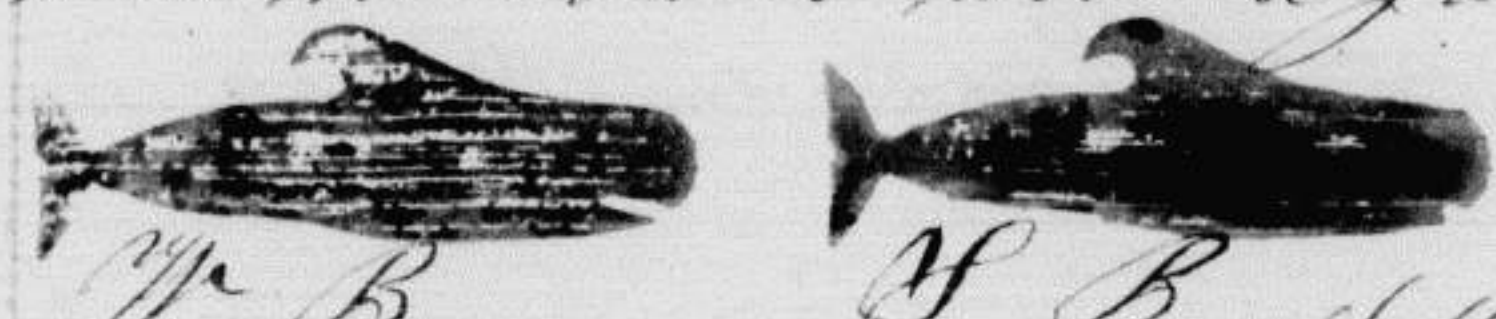
Remarks on board Friday October the 18th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from north east and good within left off south south west the watch employed in ordinary ship's duty at sundown hoisted the fore topgallant  had fine within threw the night latter part good within. So ends. Lat 23rd 00' N Long 19th 08' W

Brig Kate Carey in Passage

Remarks on board Saturday October the 19th 1861

Commenced with light breeze from the northward and good within steering south south west at five o'clock P. M. deared for Blackfish and got two one to the starboard and went back at nine o'clock came in board with them and got off south south west again had fine breeze threw the night at daylight cleared away the blackfish and mist up the blacker latter part fine breeze steering south south west nothing in sight. So ends. Lat 21st 00' N Long 19th 10' W



Remarks on board Sunday October the 20th 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from north east and good within at five o'clock P. M. started the works and hoisted out the blower got them about nine o'clock P. M. had good within threw the night at daylight cleared up the decks latter part fine breeze. So ends steering S. by E. Lat 20th 00' N Long 19th 22' W

Remarks on board Monday October the 21st 1861

Commenced with fine breeze from north east and good within saw great quantities of Porpoises at sundown took in the topgallant and hauled up the foresail at twelve o'clock P. M. left to the wind with the head yards aback at daylight left off south by west and made sail latter part strong breeze nothing in sight steering S. by W. So ends. Lat 19th 24' N Long 20th 20' W
